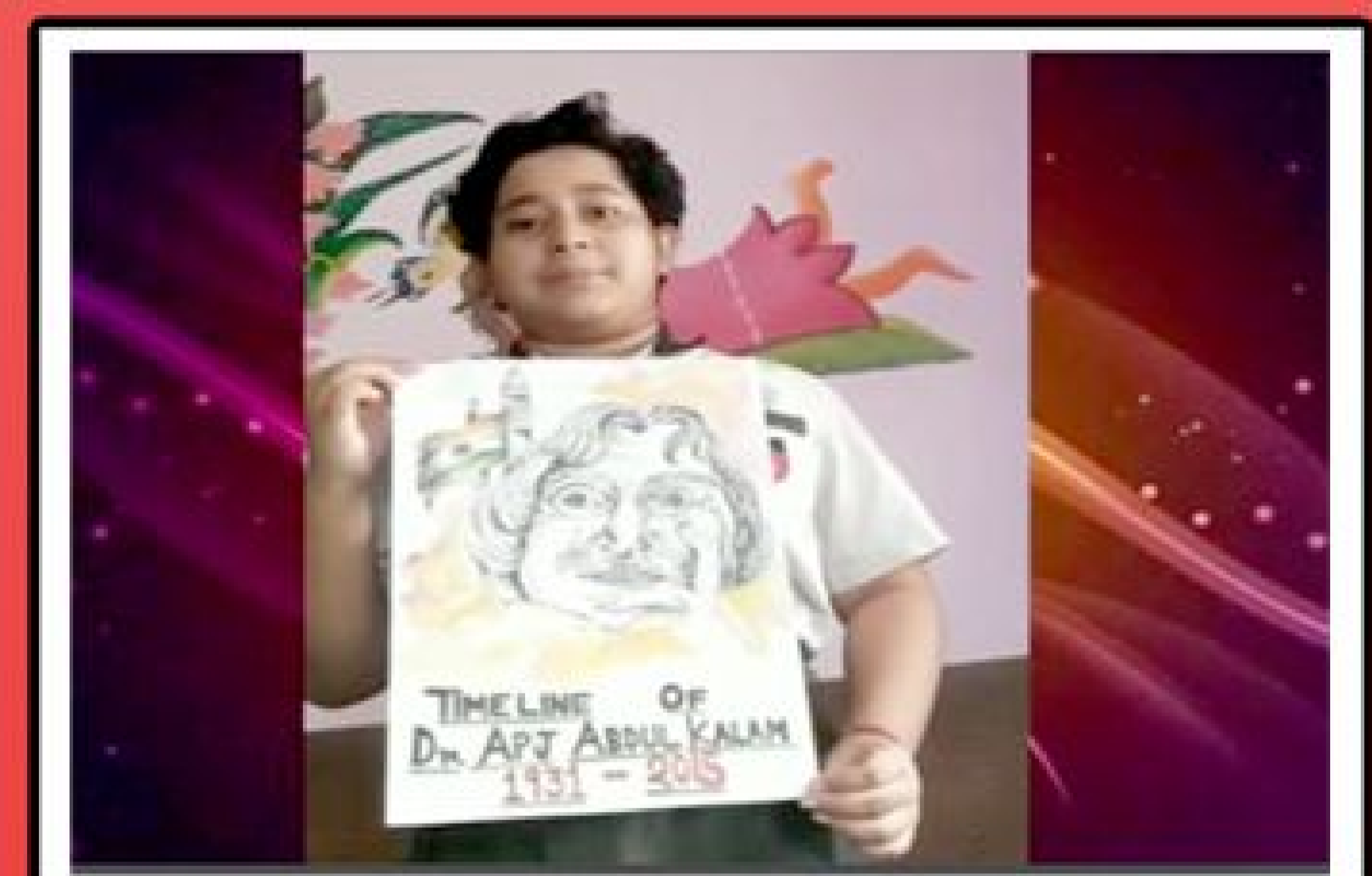
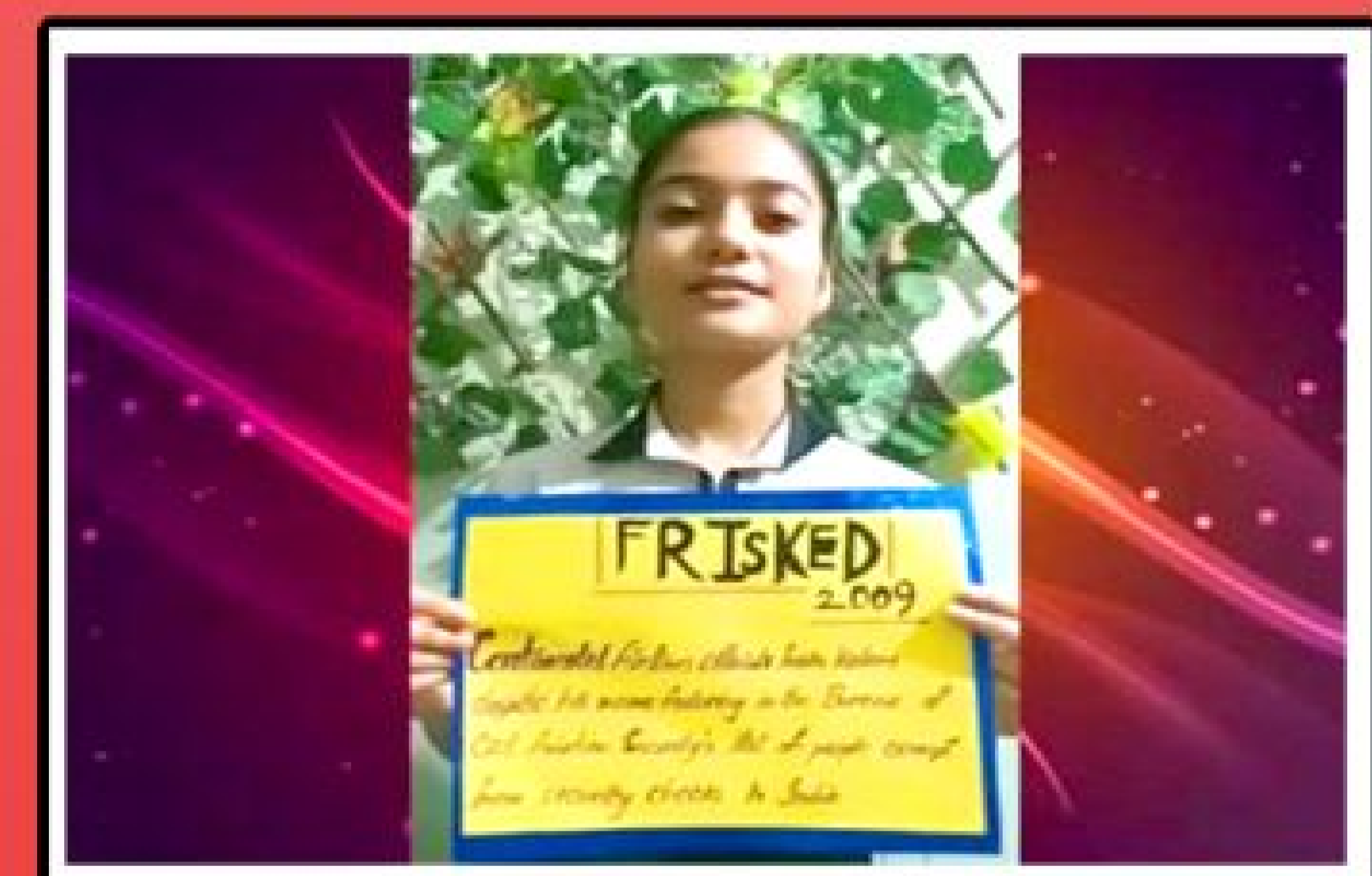
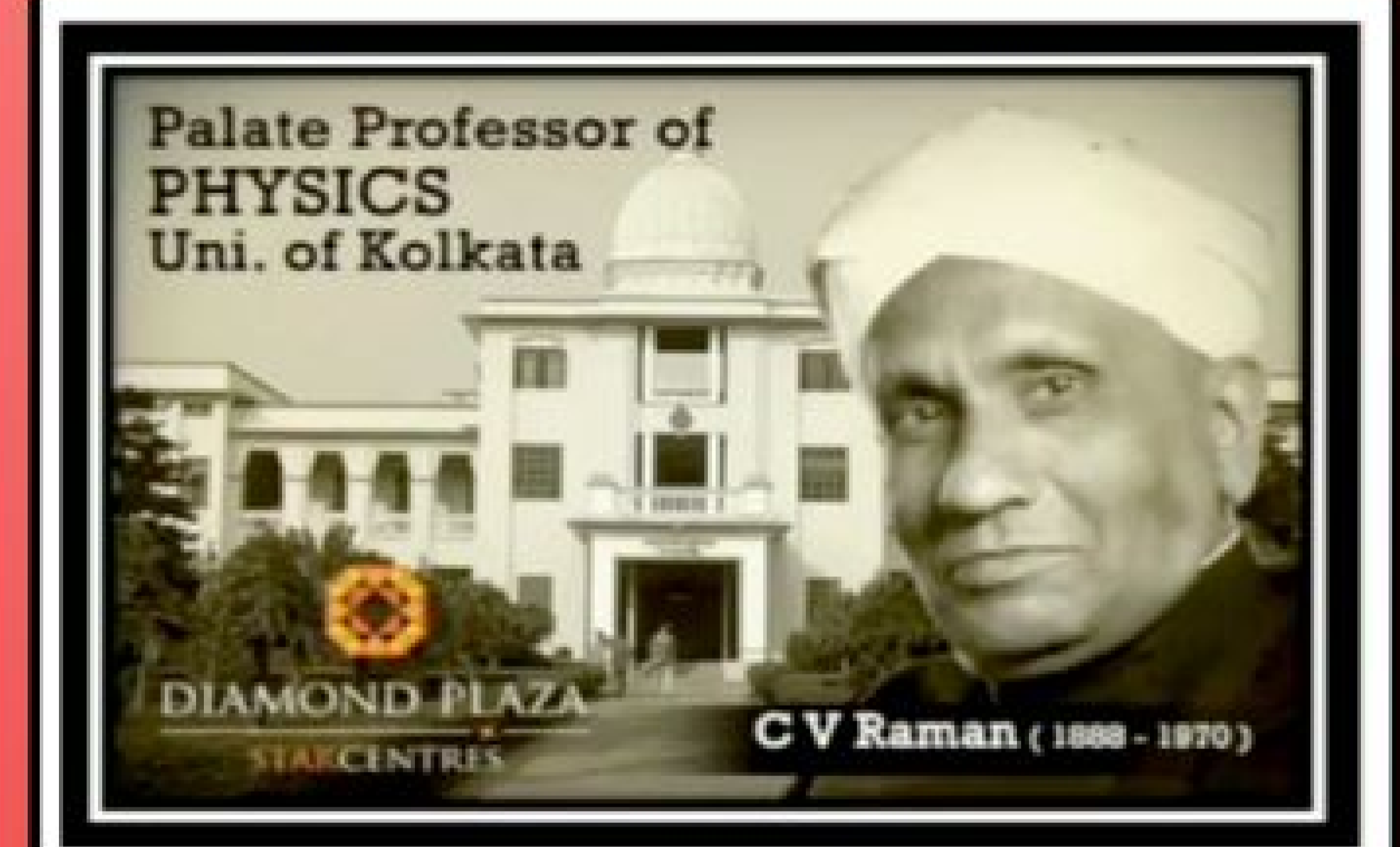


## INNOVATIVE PRACTICES

### SPECIAL ASSEMBLY



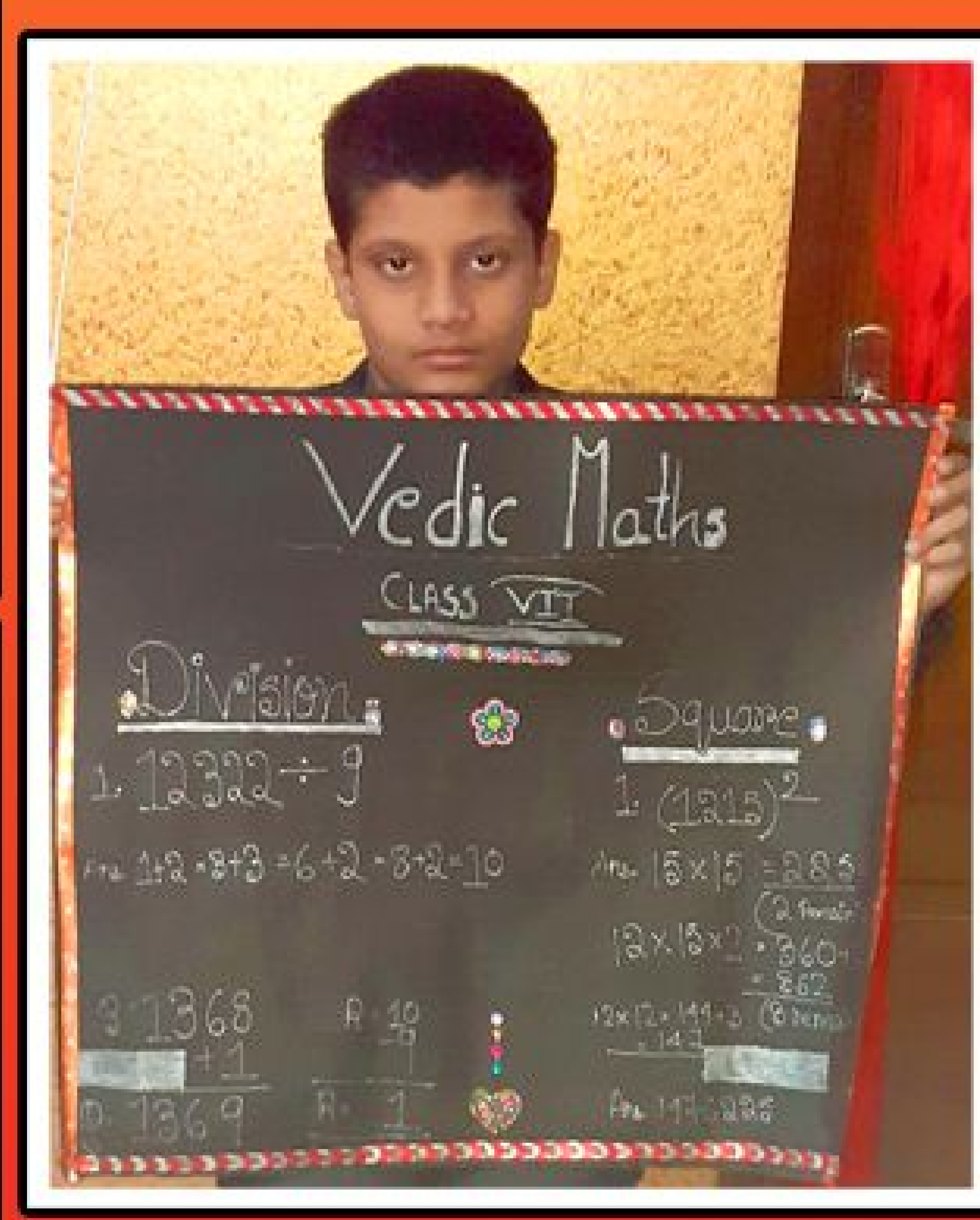
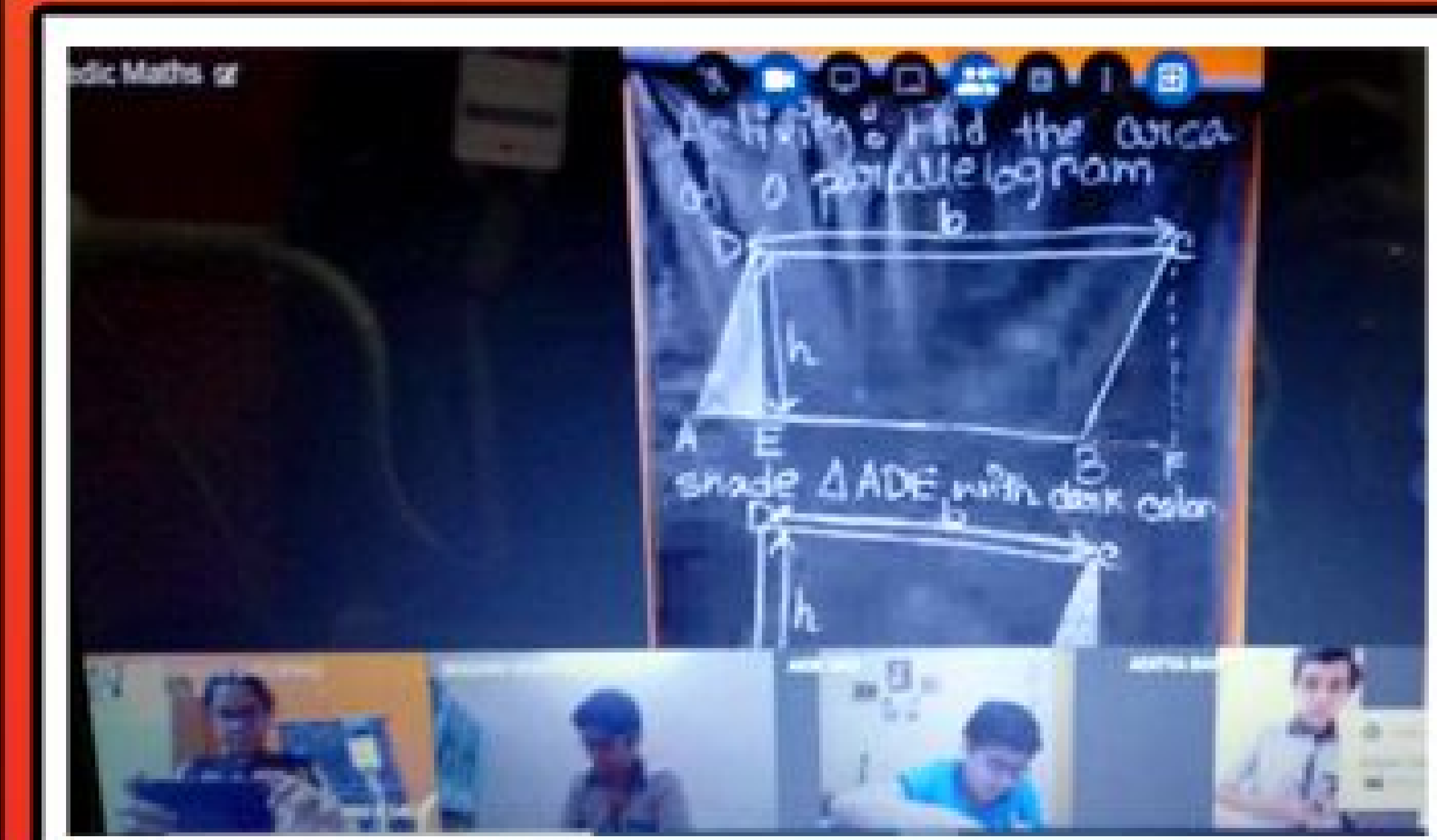
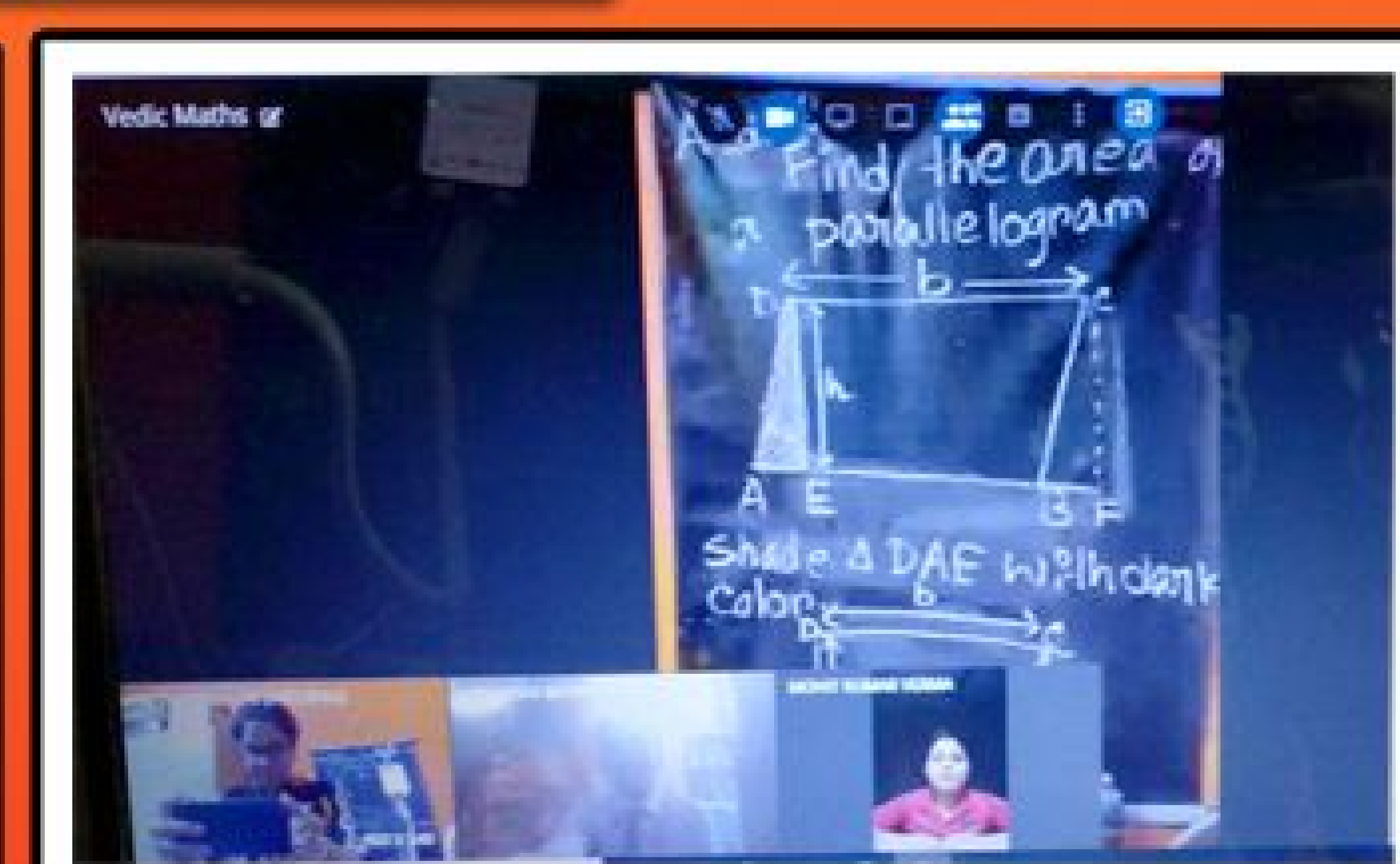

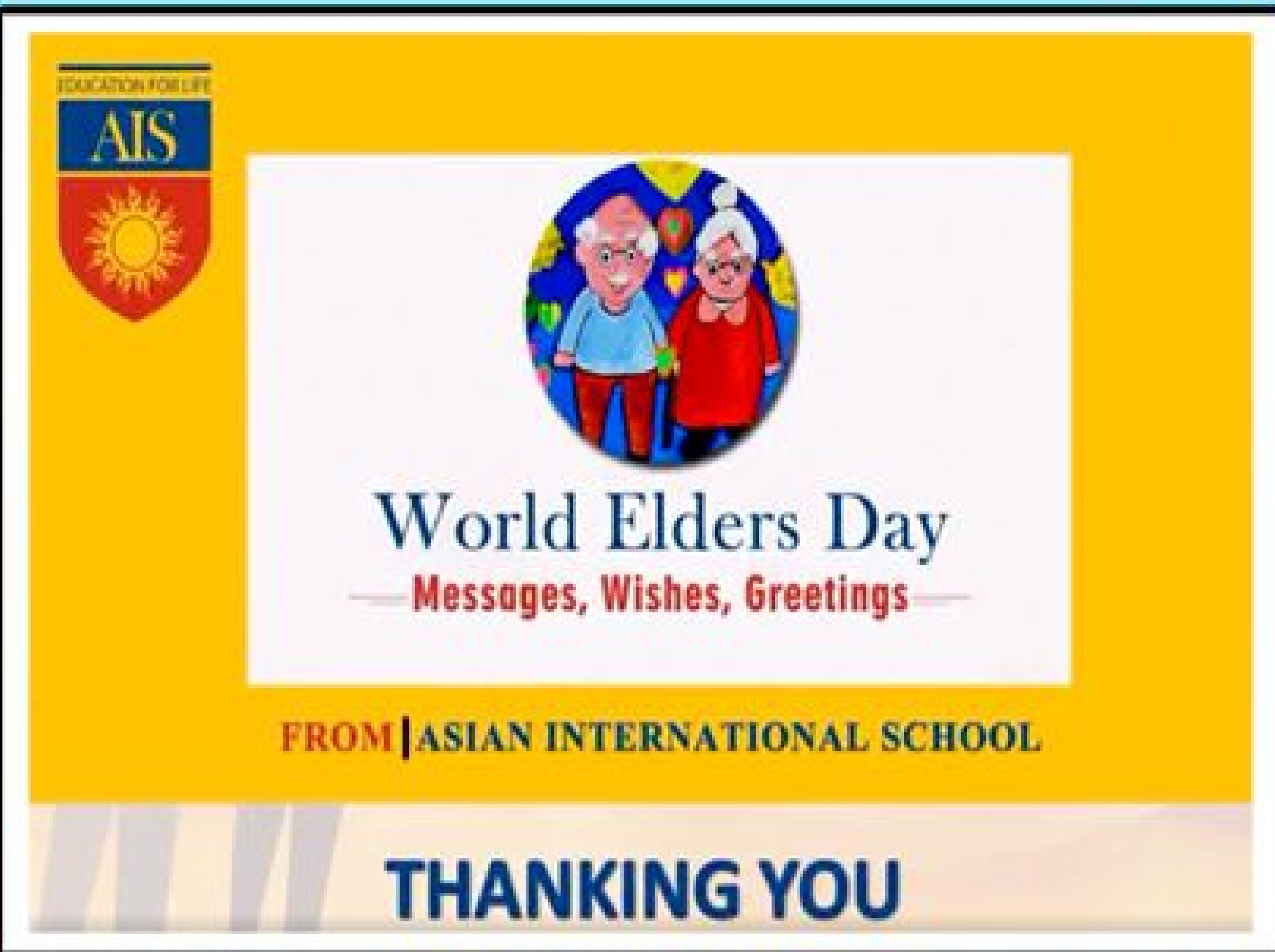
## HOME BASED SCIENCE EXPERIMENTS

Turning kitchens into scientific laboratories is yet another practice started by the fount of innovation, Asian International School. To test the scientific theories and to provide the basis for scientific knowledge the enthusiastic students turned their **kitchens into laboratories**, thereby using their easily available kitchen utensils and commodities into lab equipments. Under the continuous admonition of their teachers during their online classes, these students perform various experiments. Some of the experiments conducted by them at home were –the process of **osmosis using a potato osmoscope**, study of the time period of a simple pendulum, demonstration of the mechanism of breathing using a model with birthday balloons, demonstration of the process of transpiration in plants from their leaves thereby proving the fact that exhaled air contains carbon dioxide etc.. The students thoroughly enjoy performing these experiments and practical learning from them in the process.





## WORLD ELDER'S DAY - WEBINAR

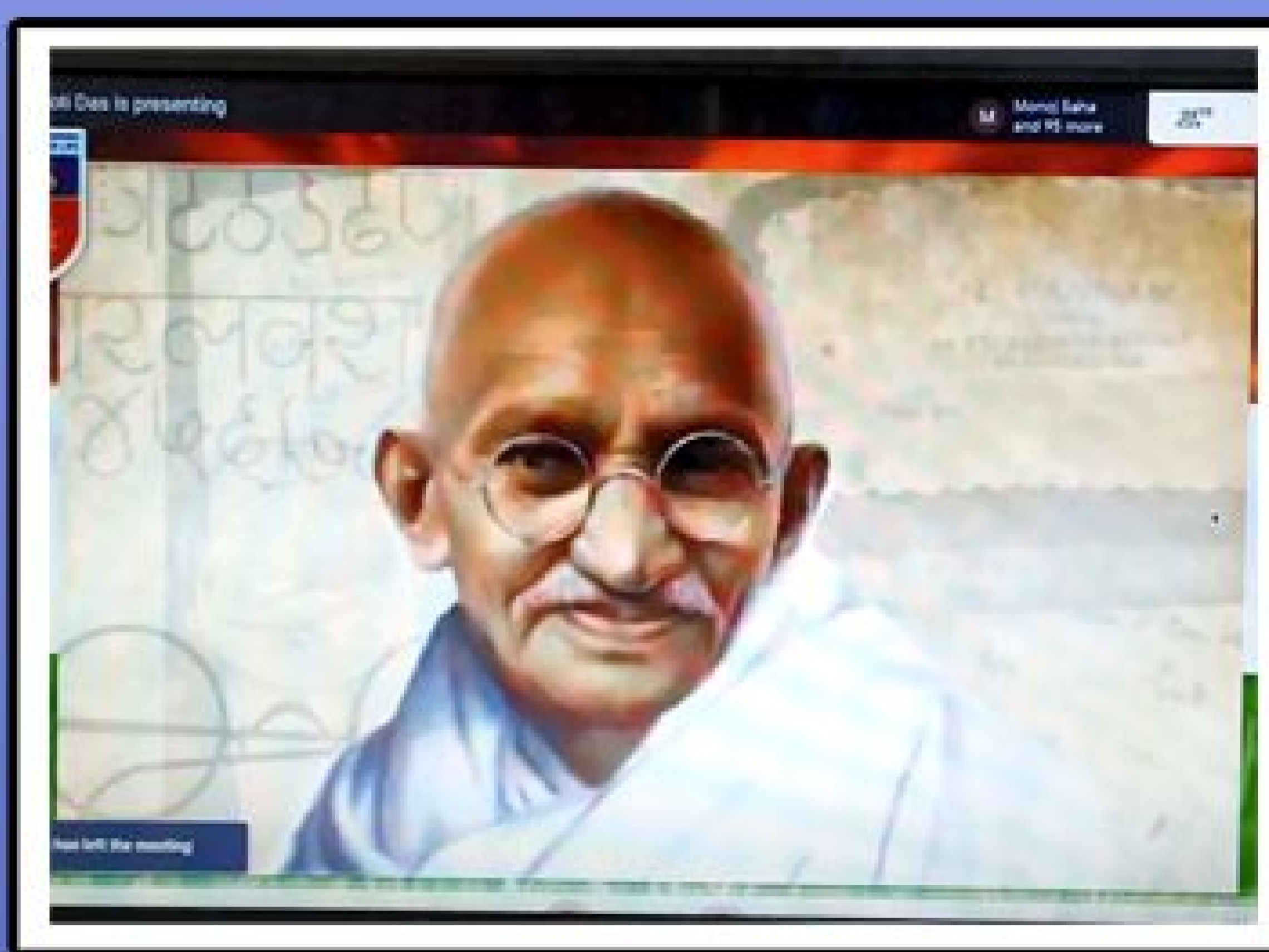
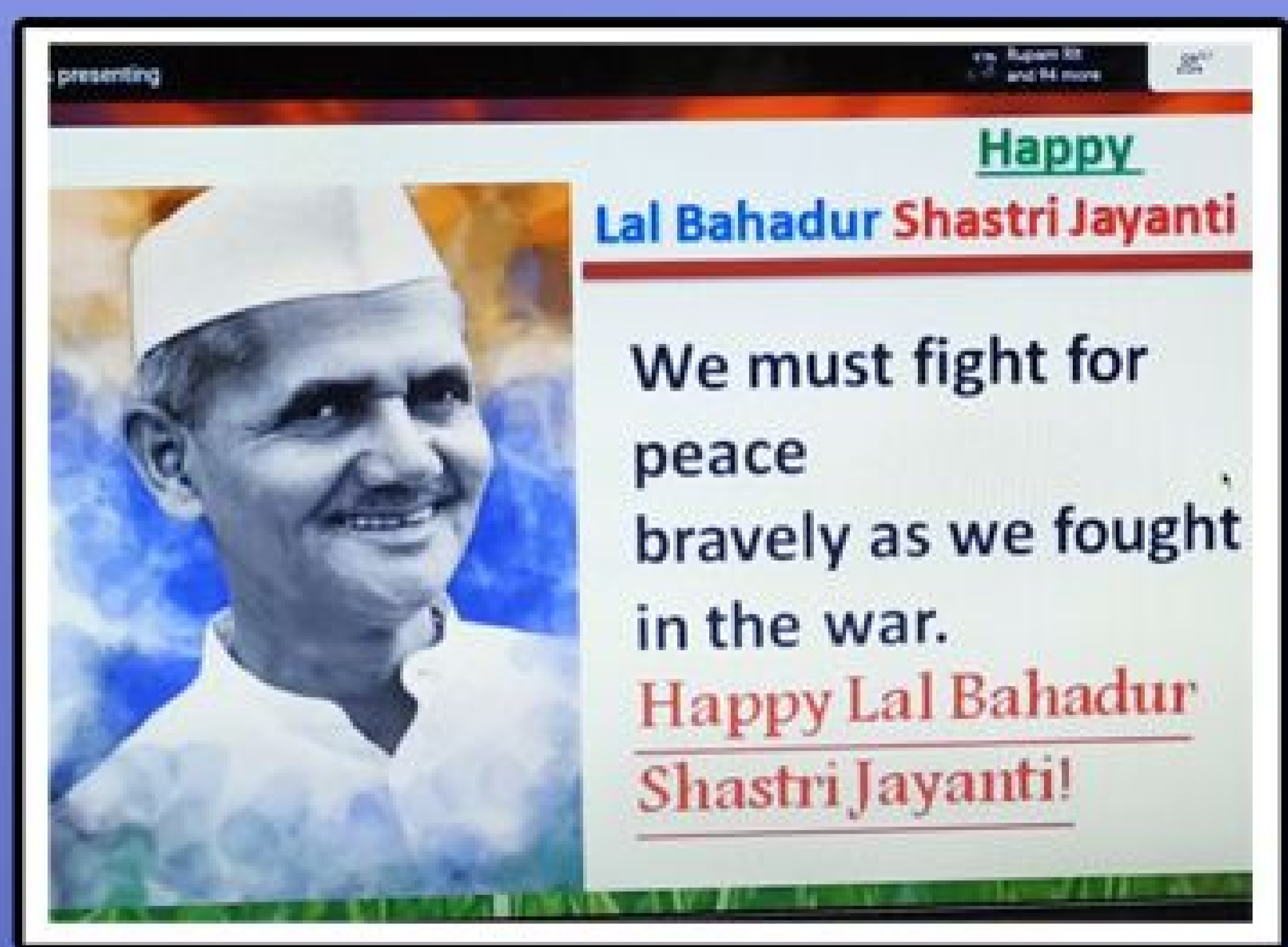
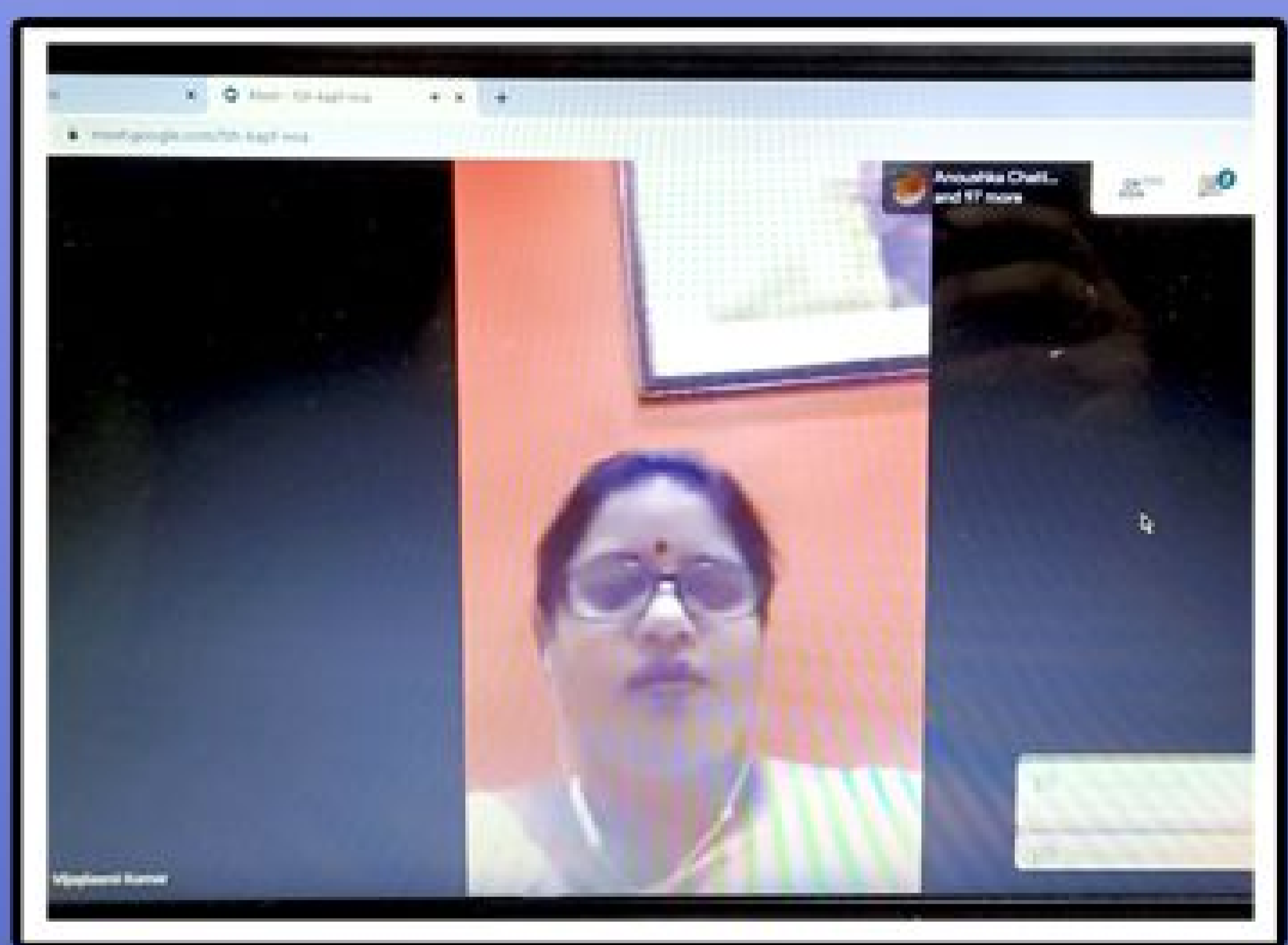
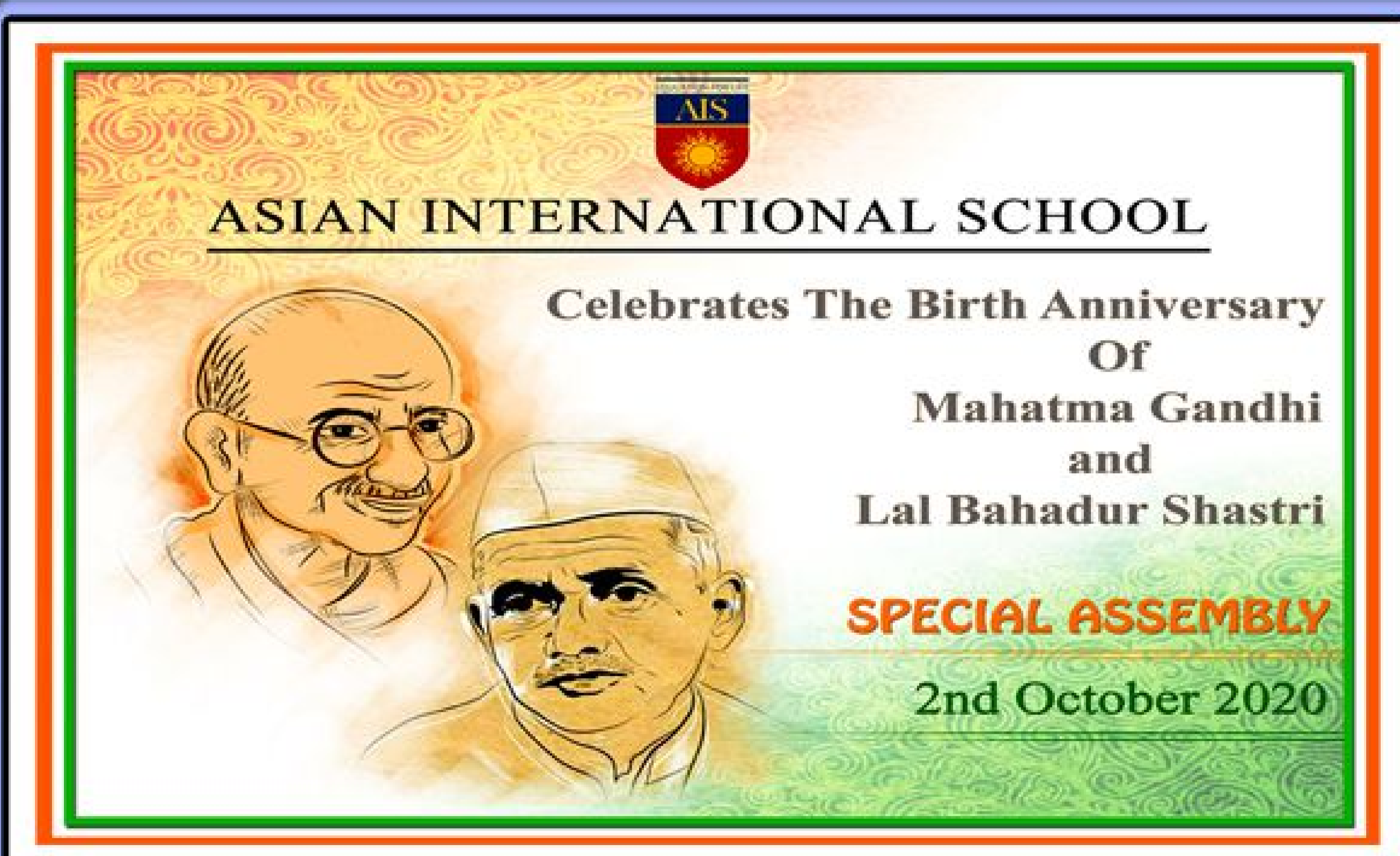

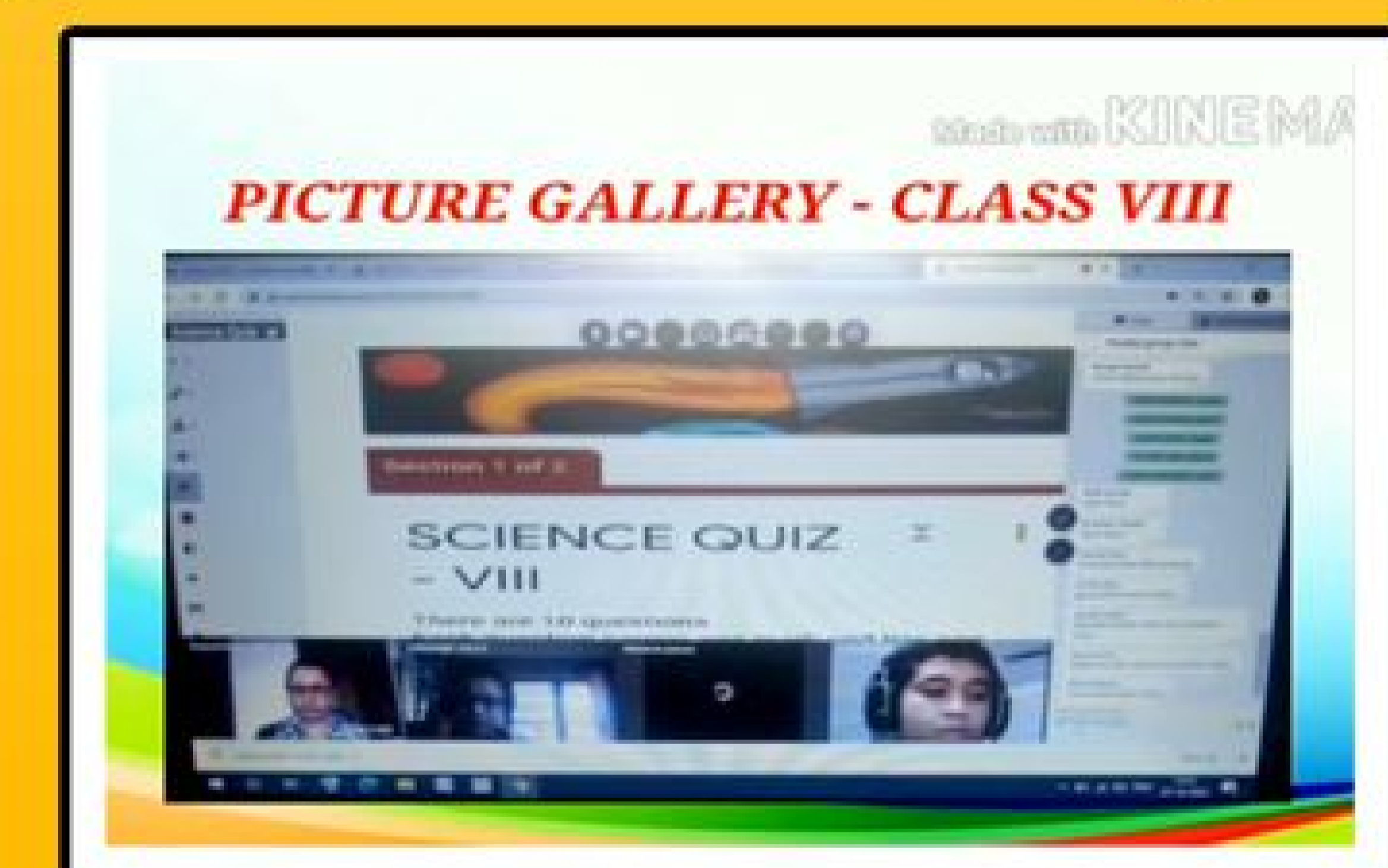
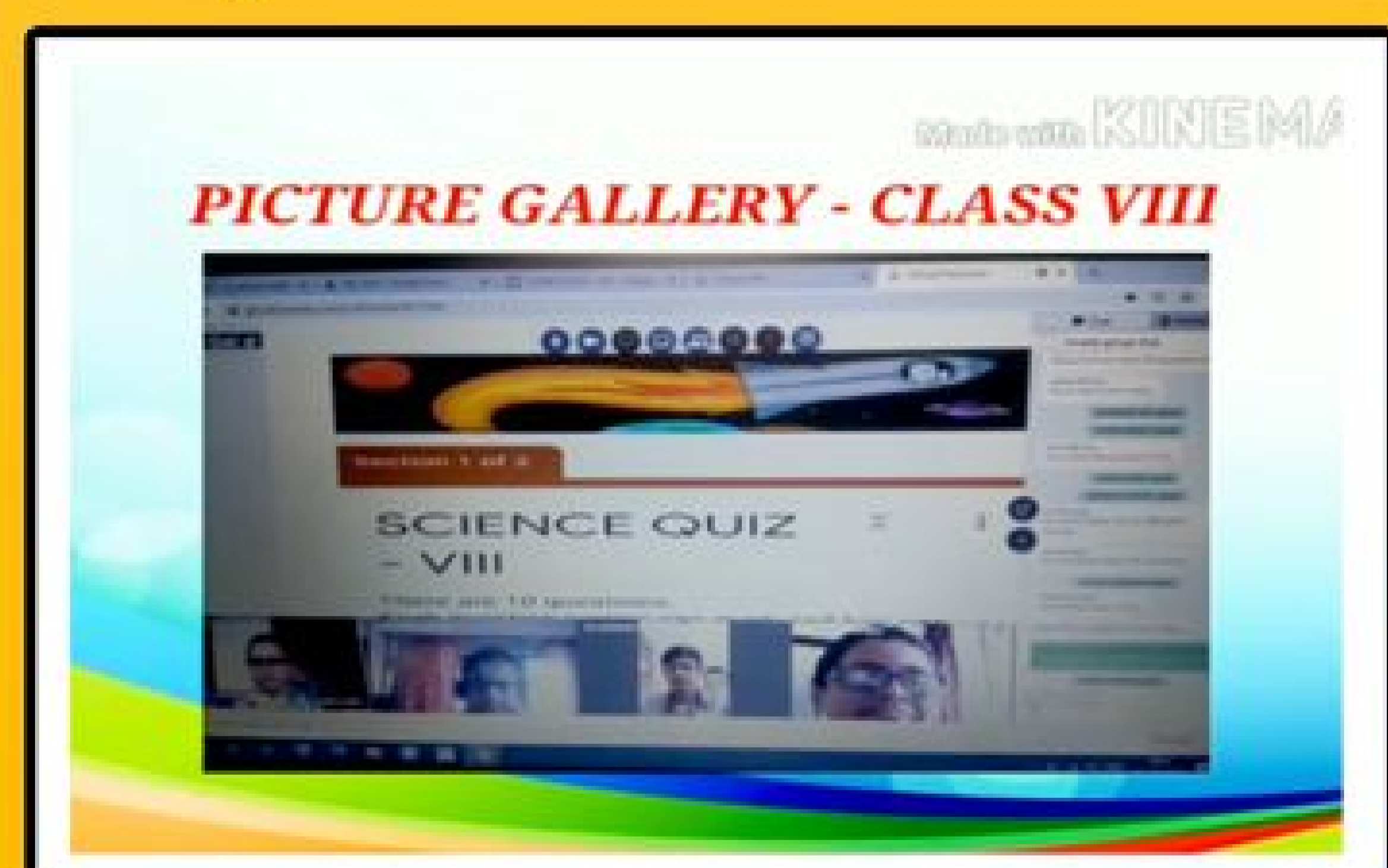
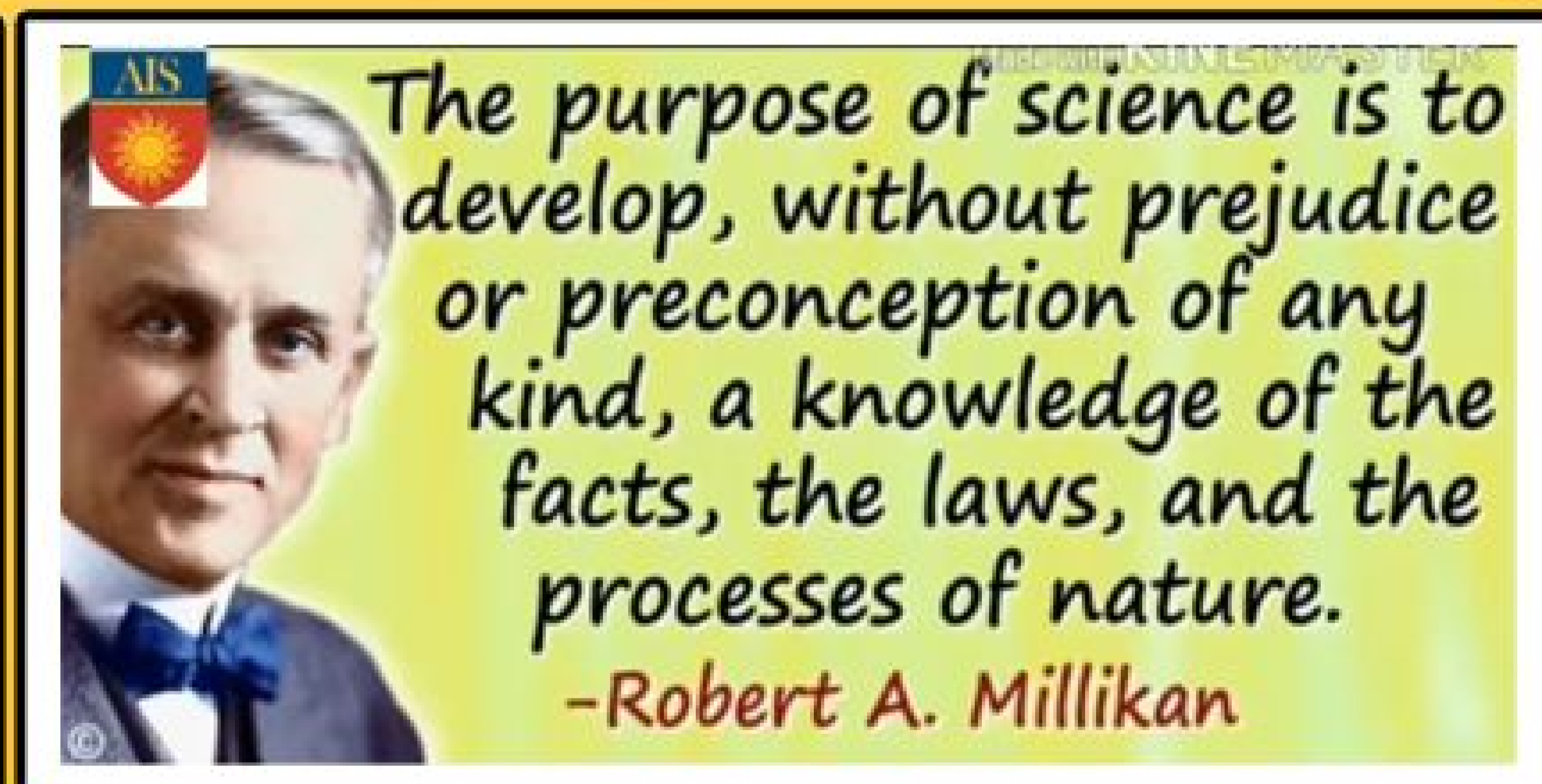
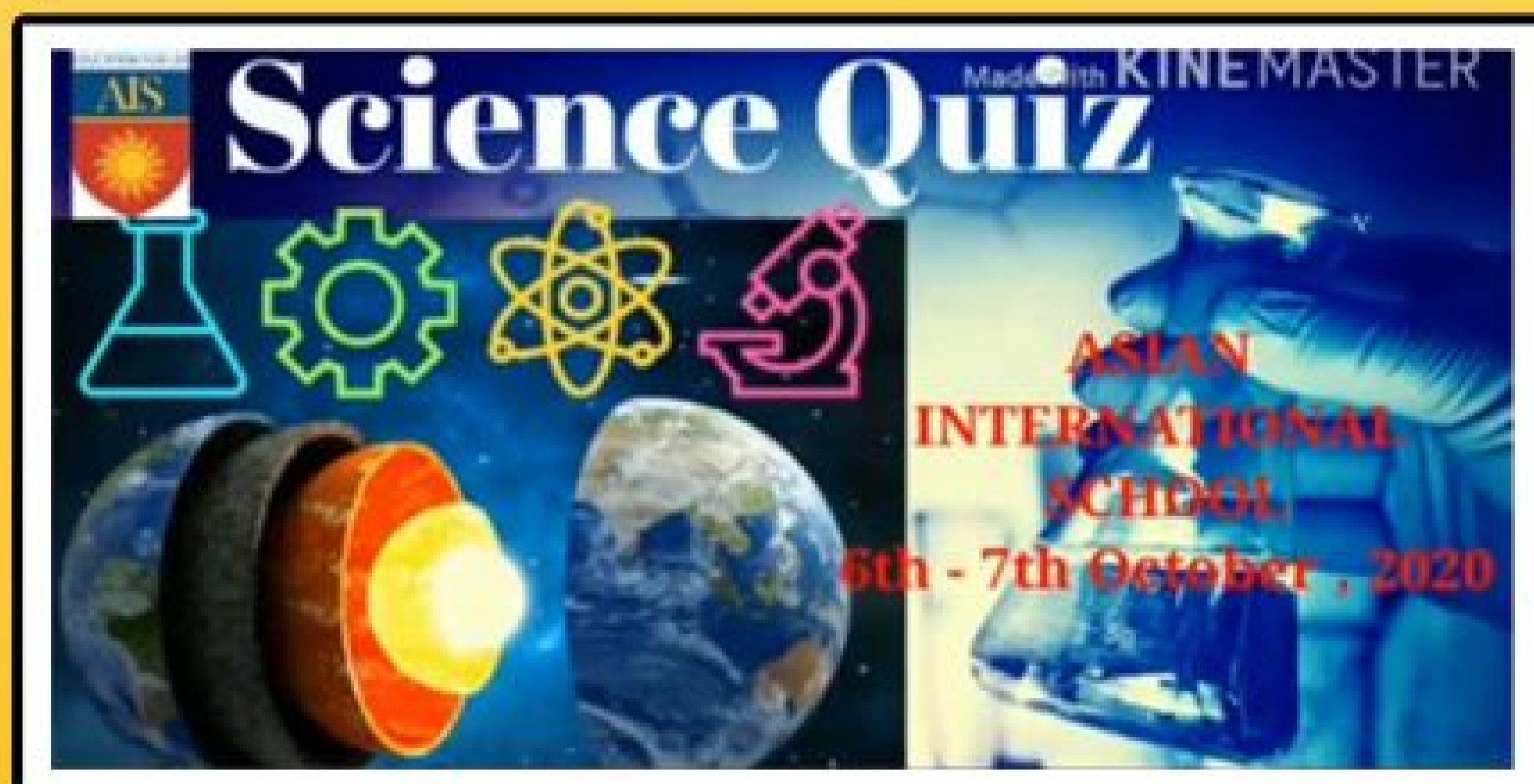
## SHOW AND TELL ACTIVITY

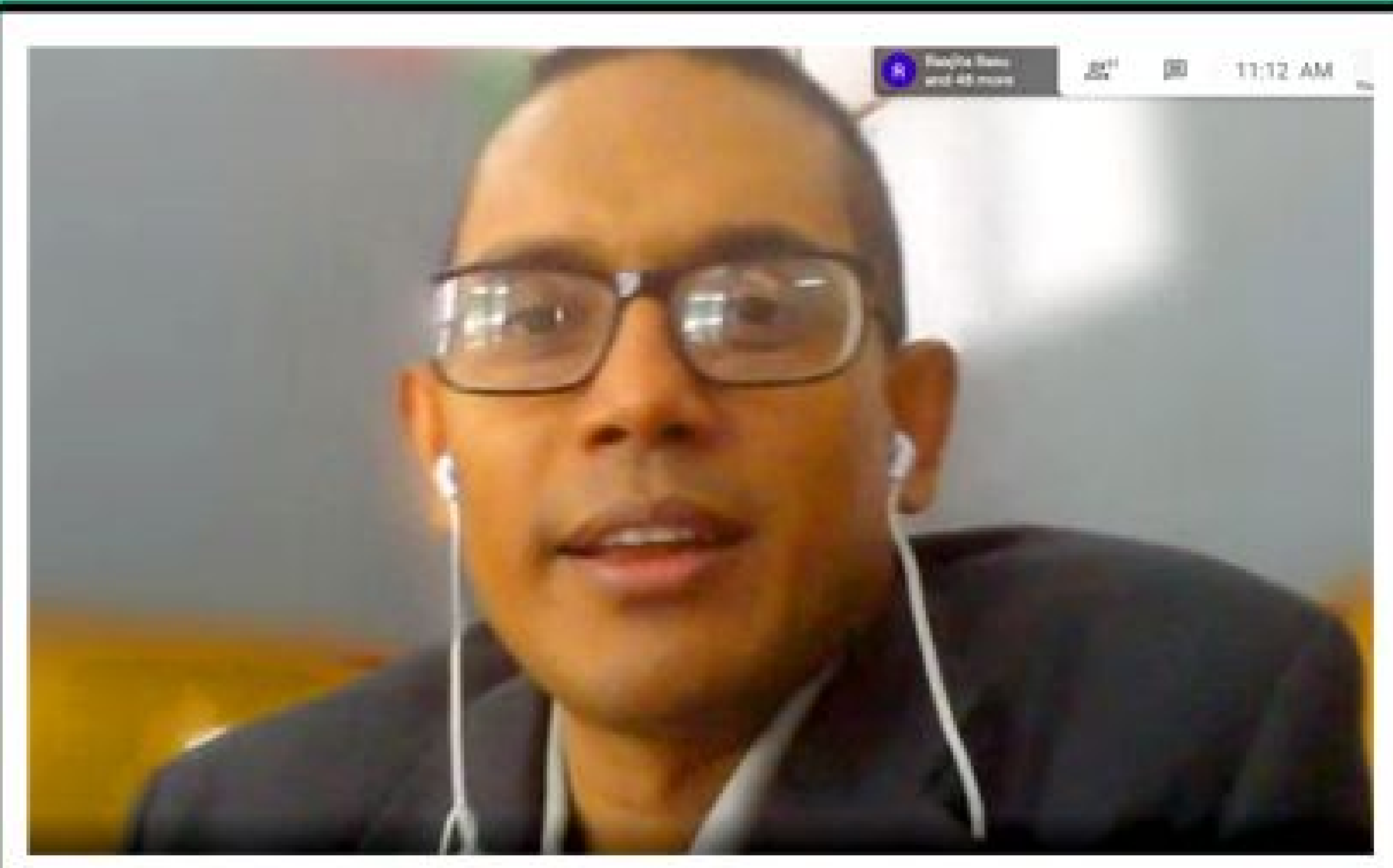
## GUINNESS WORLD RECORD - VVM

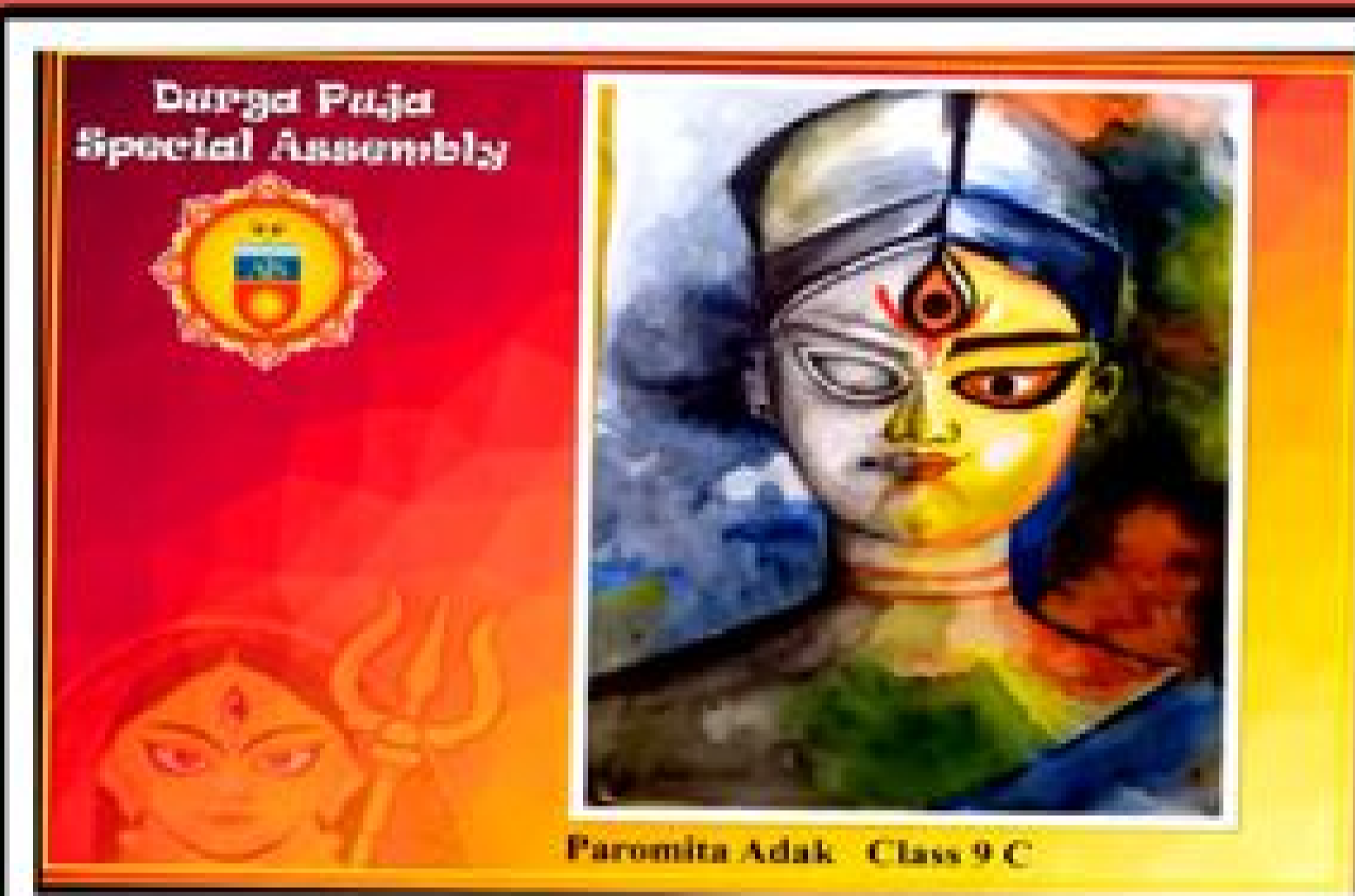
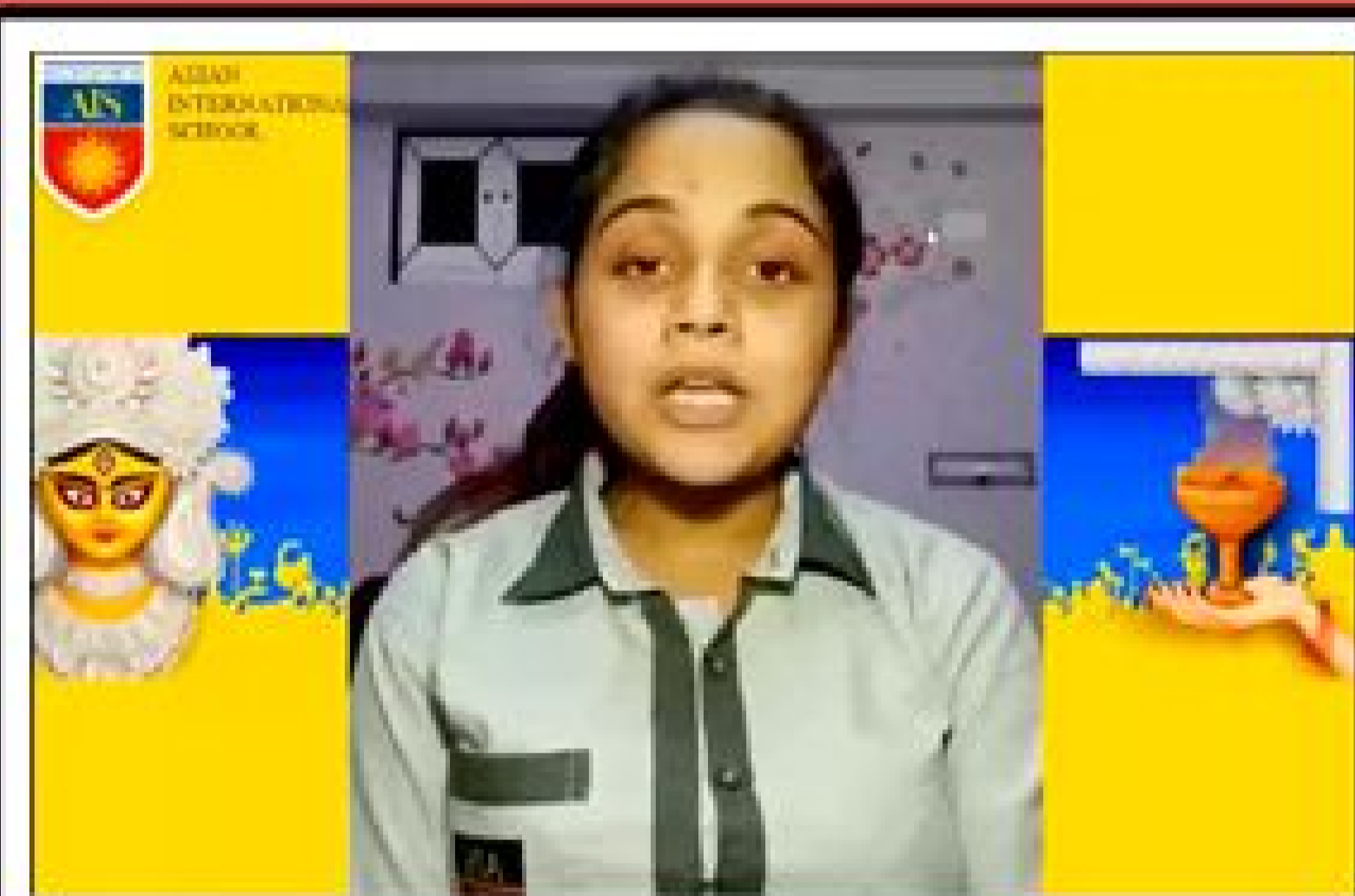
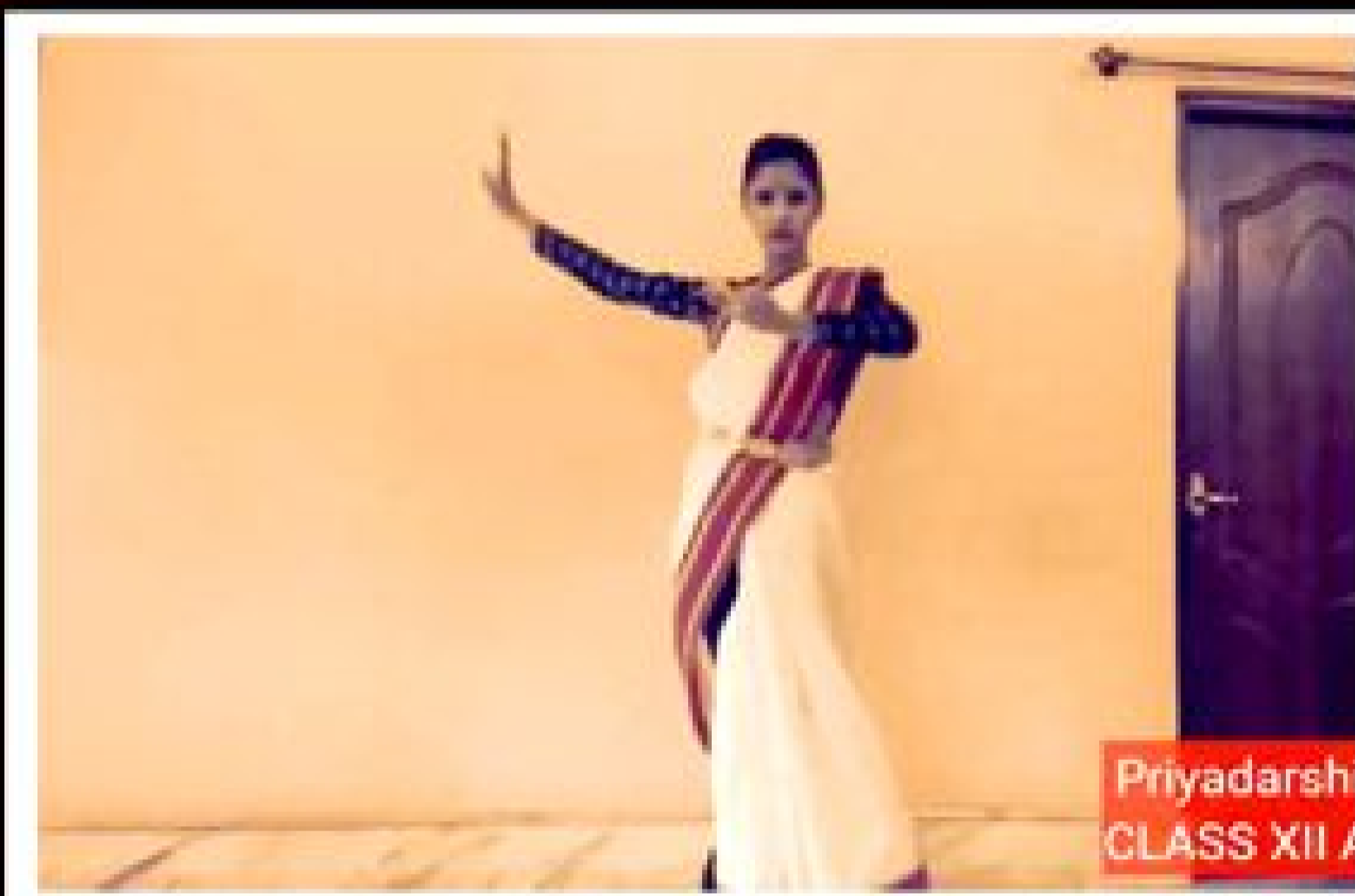
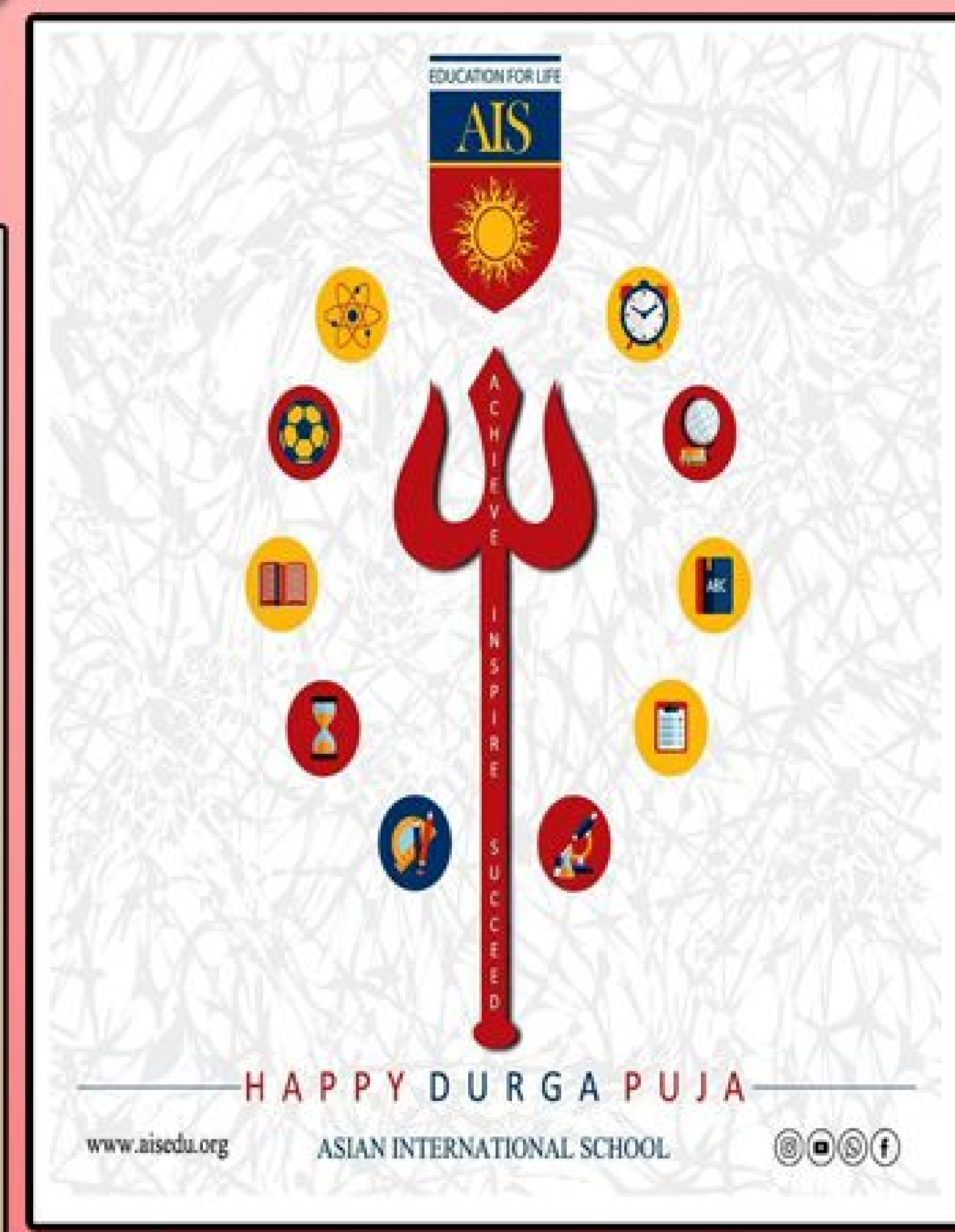




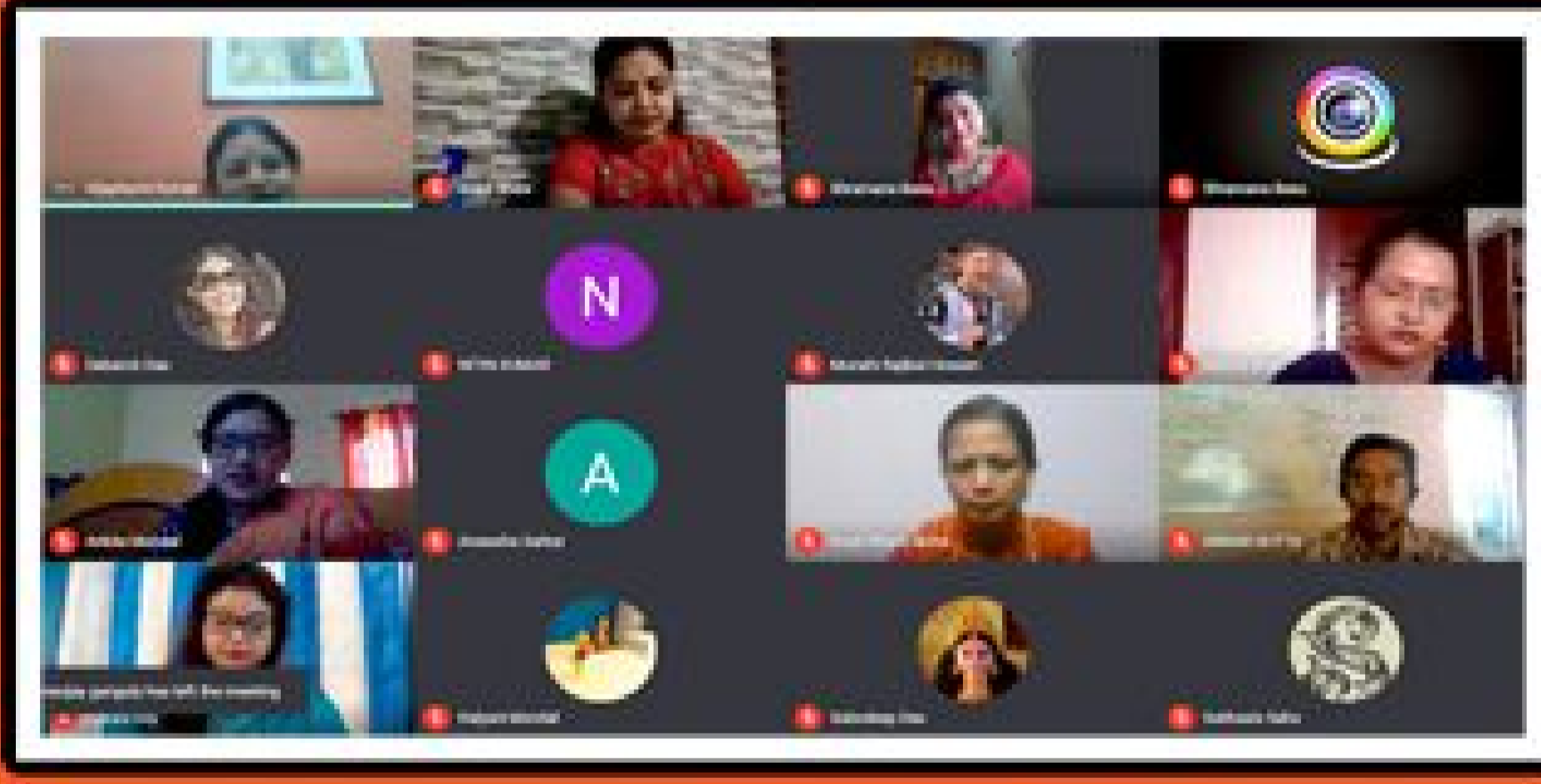
## DURGA PUJA ONLINE CELEBRATION



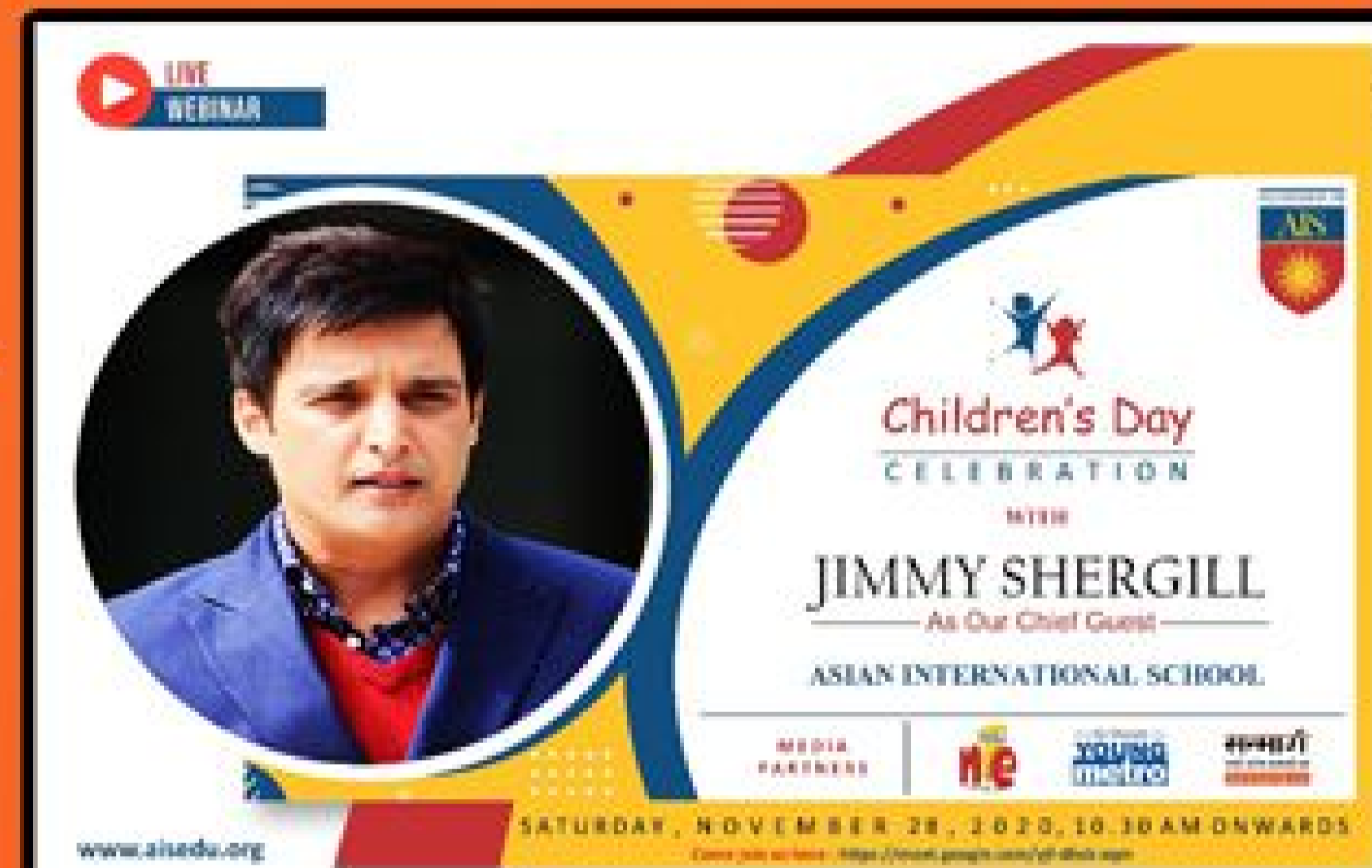

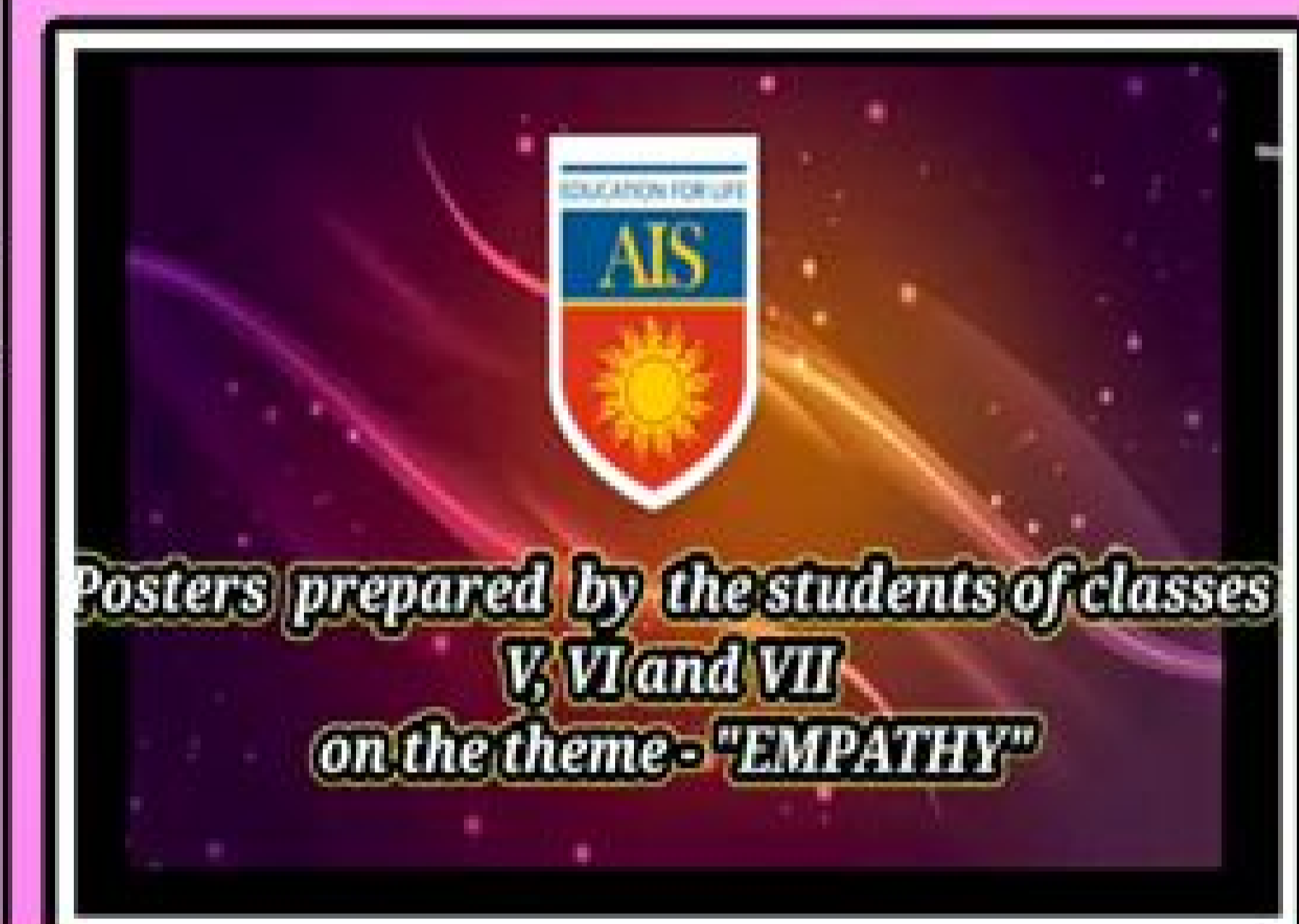
## NATIONAL VIGILANCE WEEK

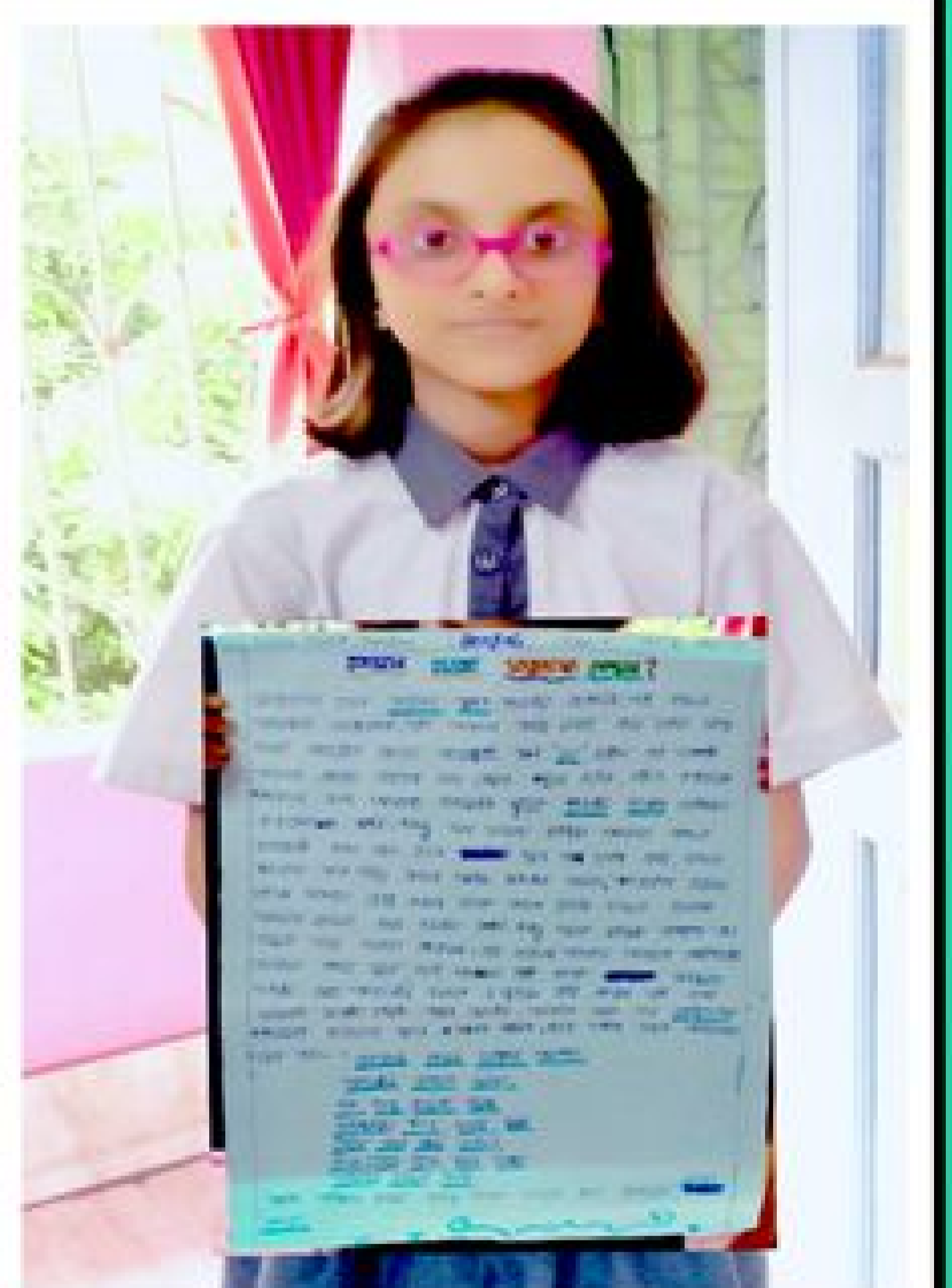
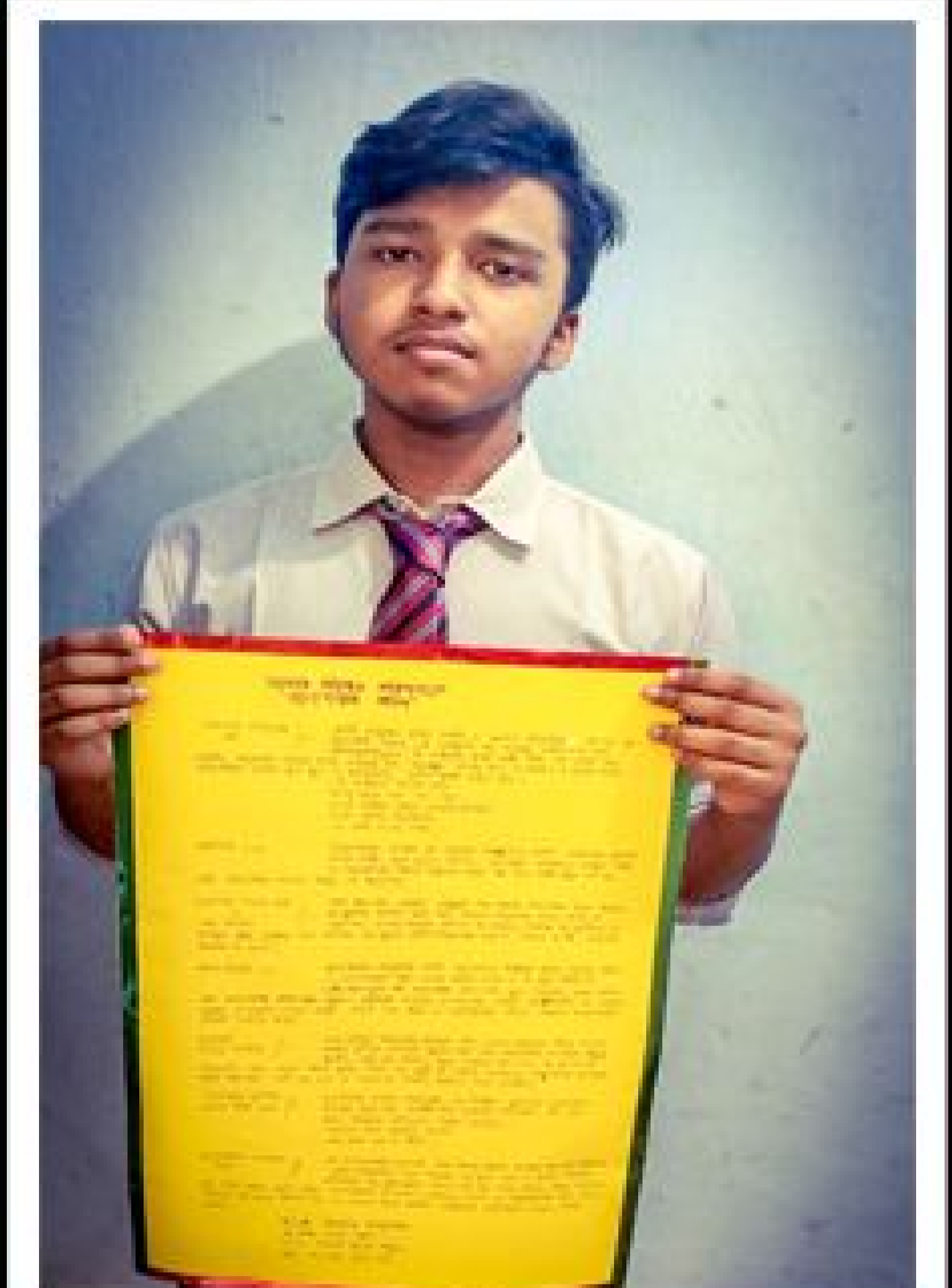
## CONSTITUTION DAY CELEBRATION

## VERNACULAR WEEK CELEBRATION

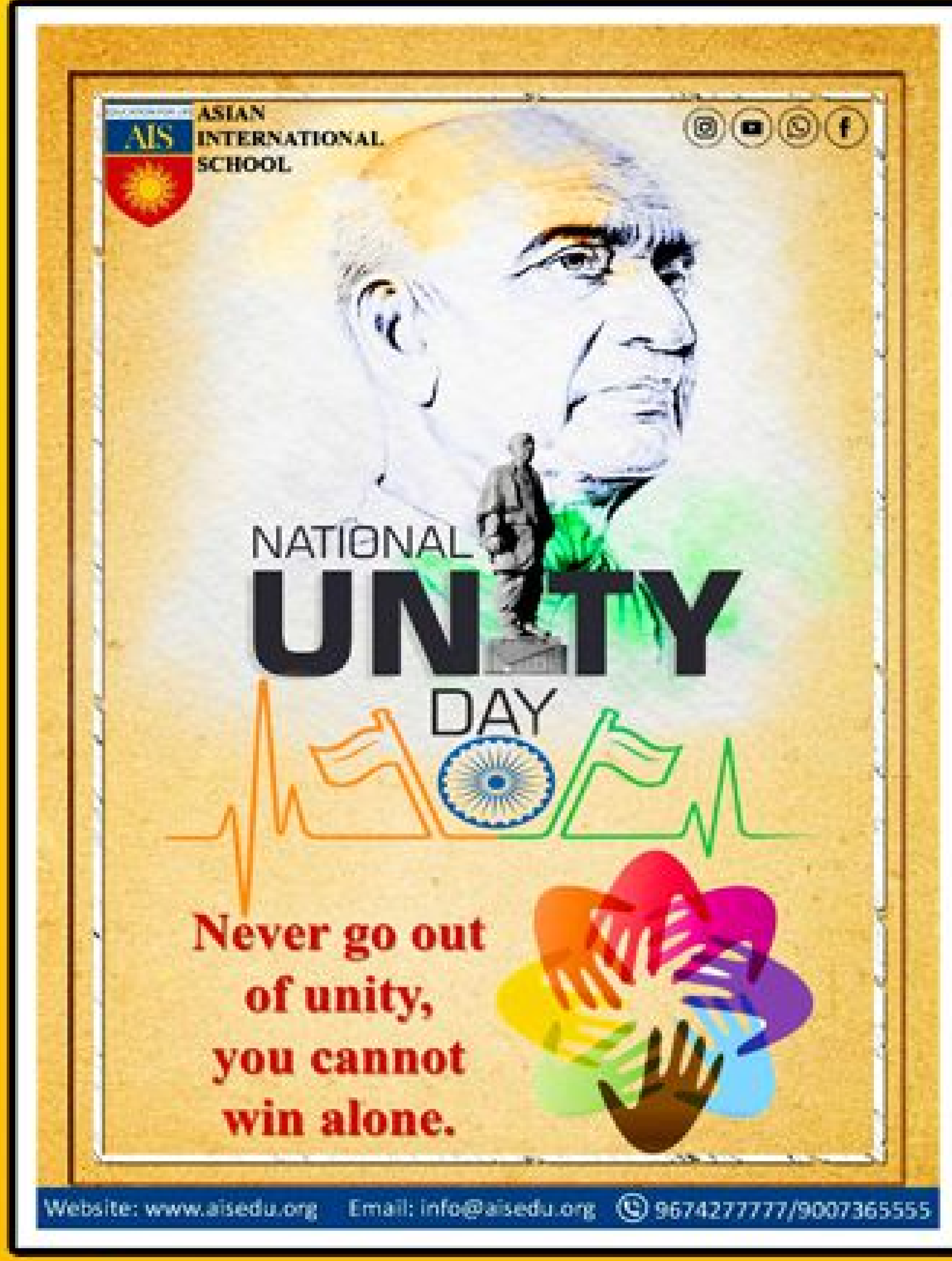
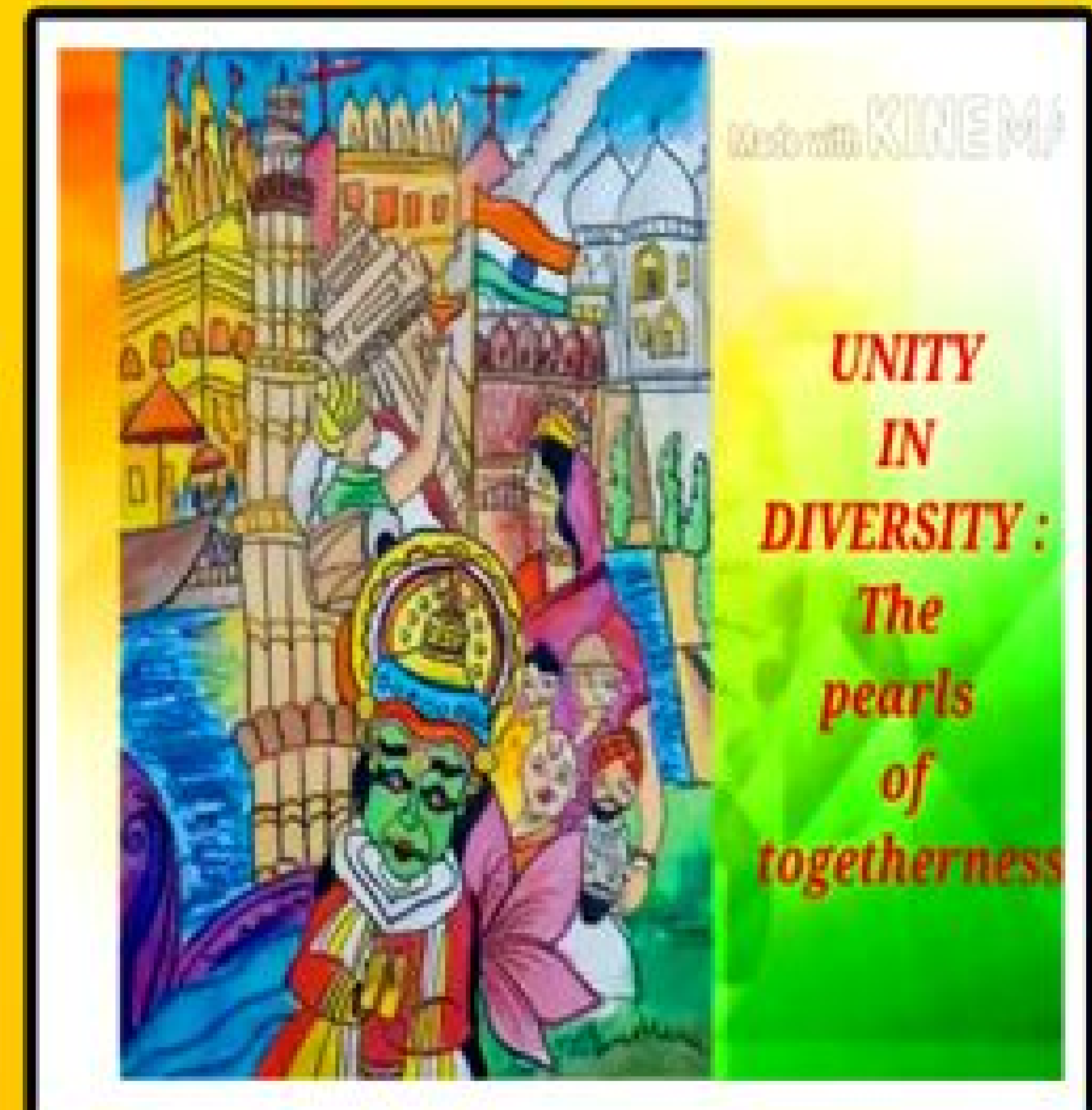

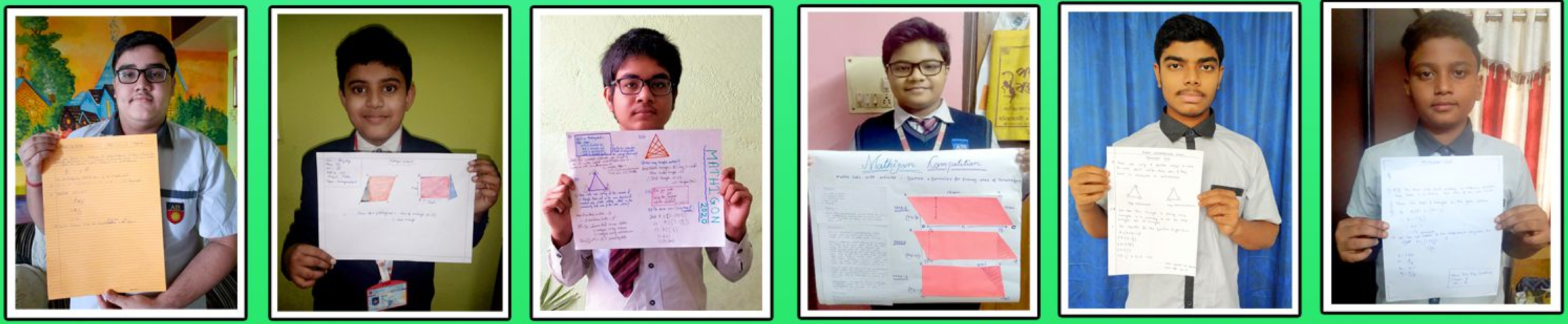




## MATHIGON ACTIVITY

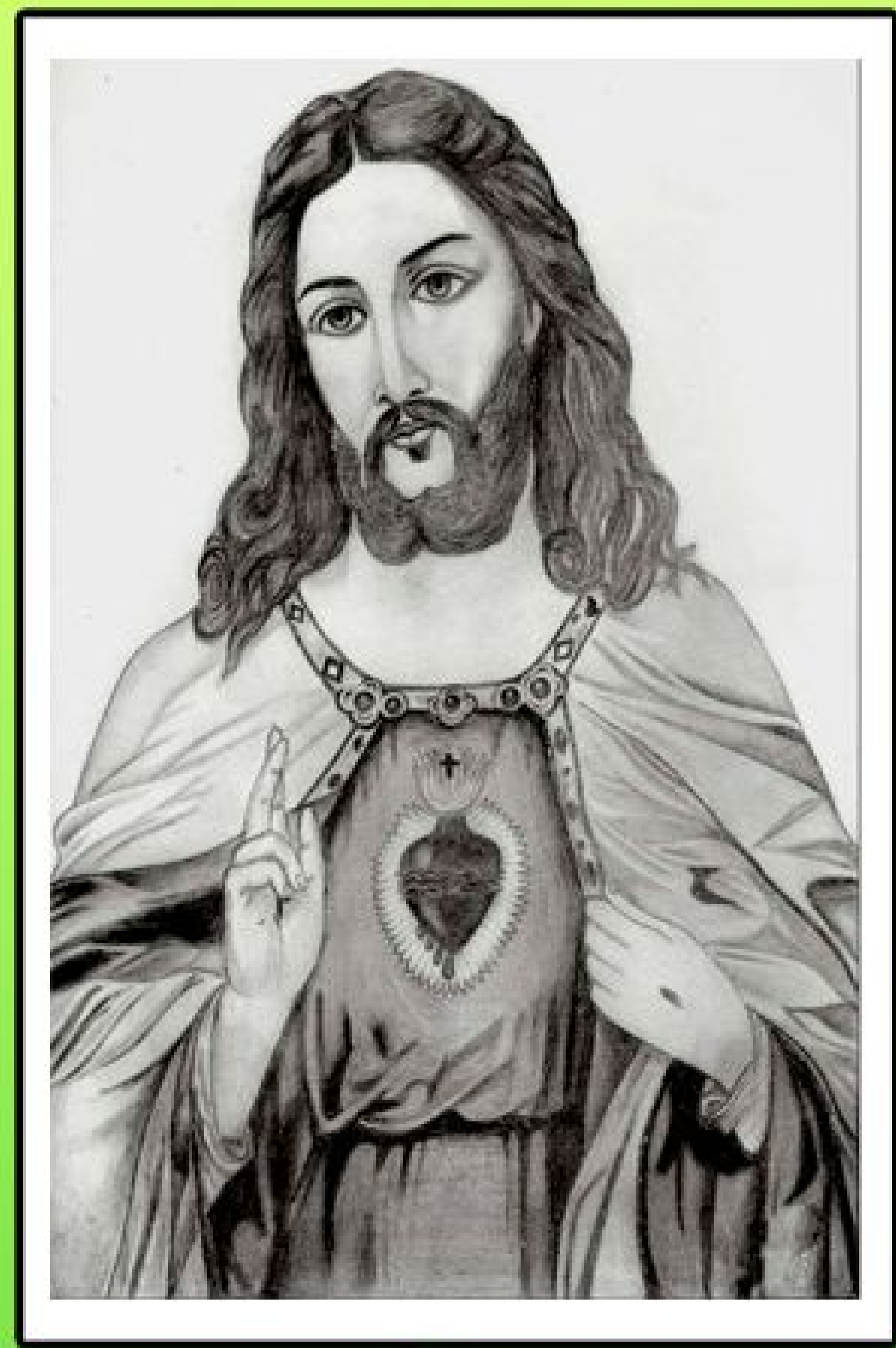

## POSTER MAKING - GOOD CITIZENSHIP



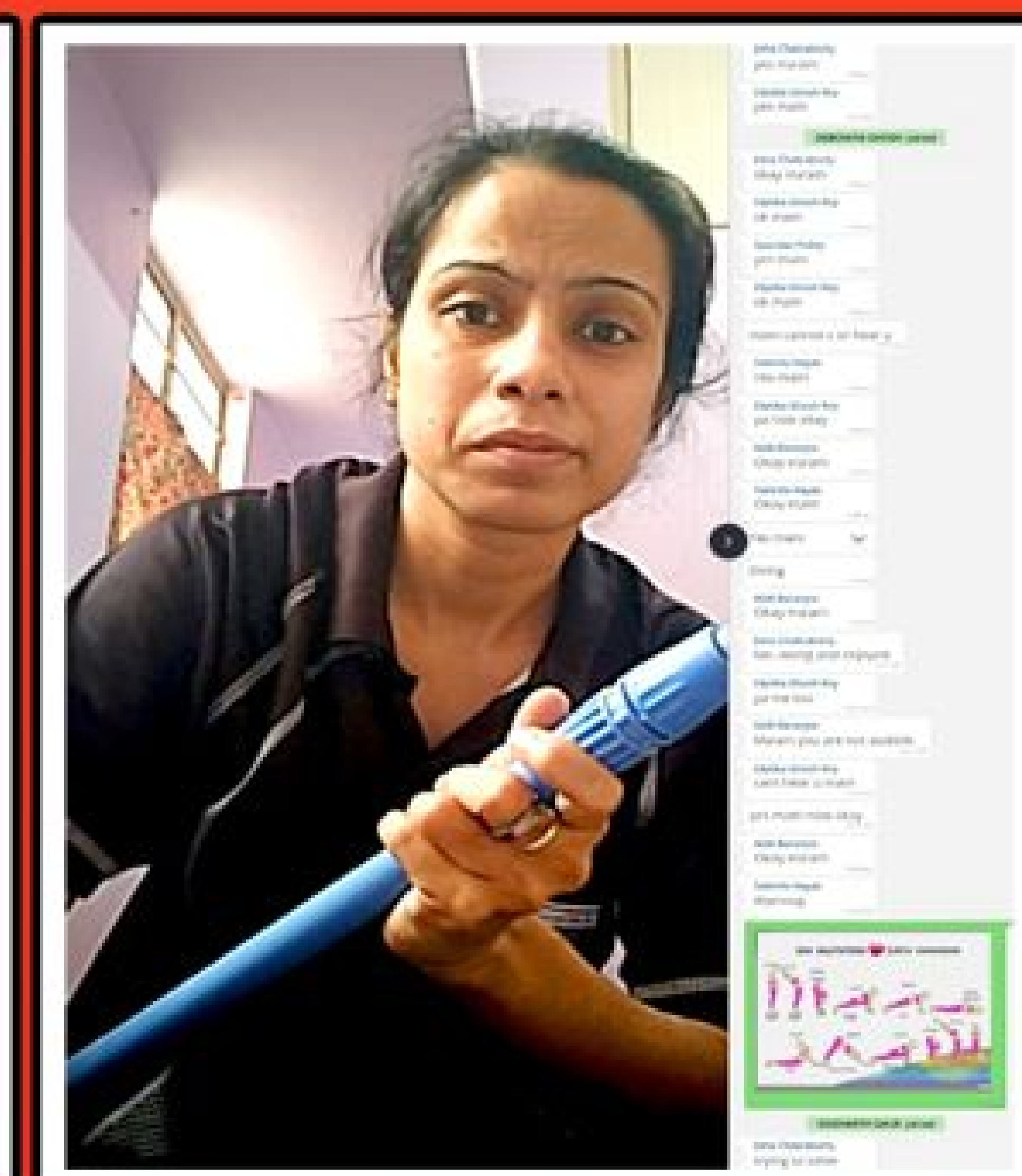

## REGALIA, 2020



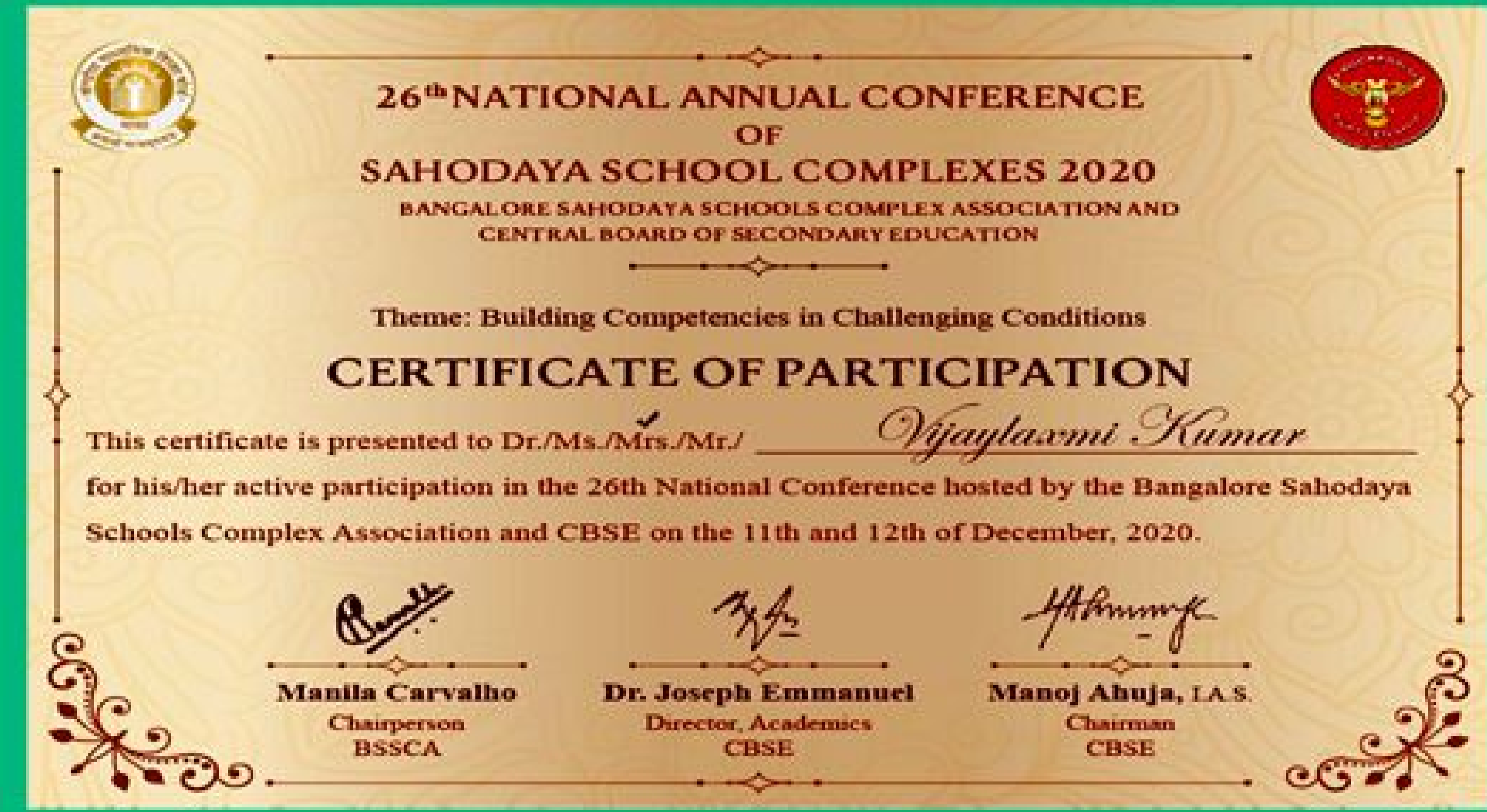
