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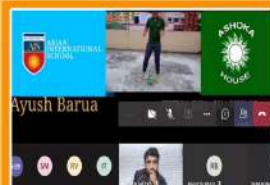
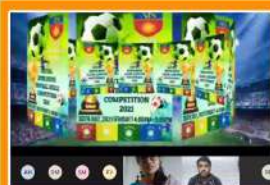
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## VIRTUAL FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT

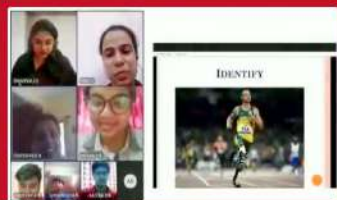

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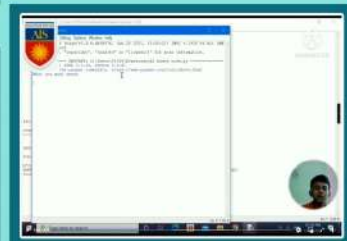
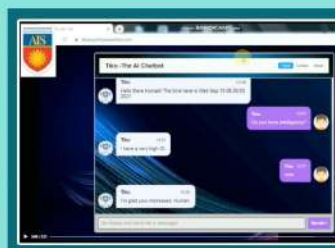
## PREMCHAND JAYANTI CELEBRATION

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## HINDI DIWAS



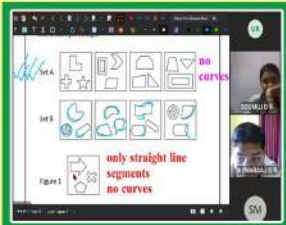
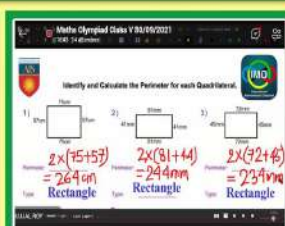

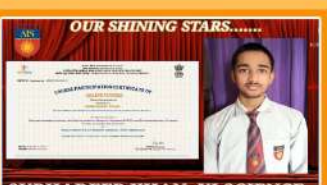
### ADAXENIA 2021
