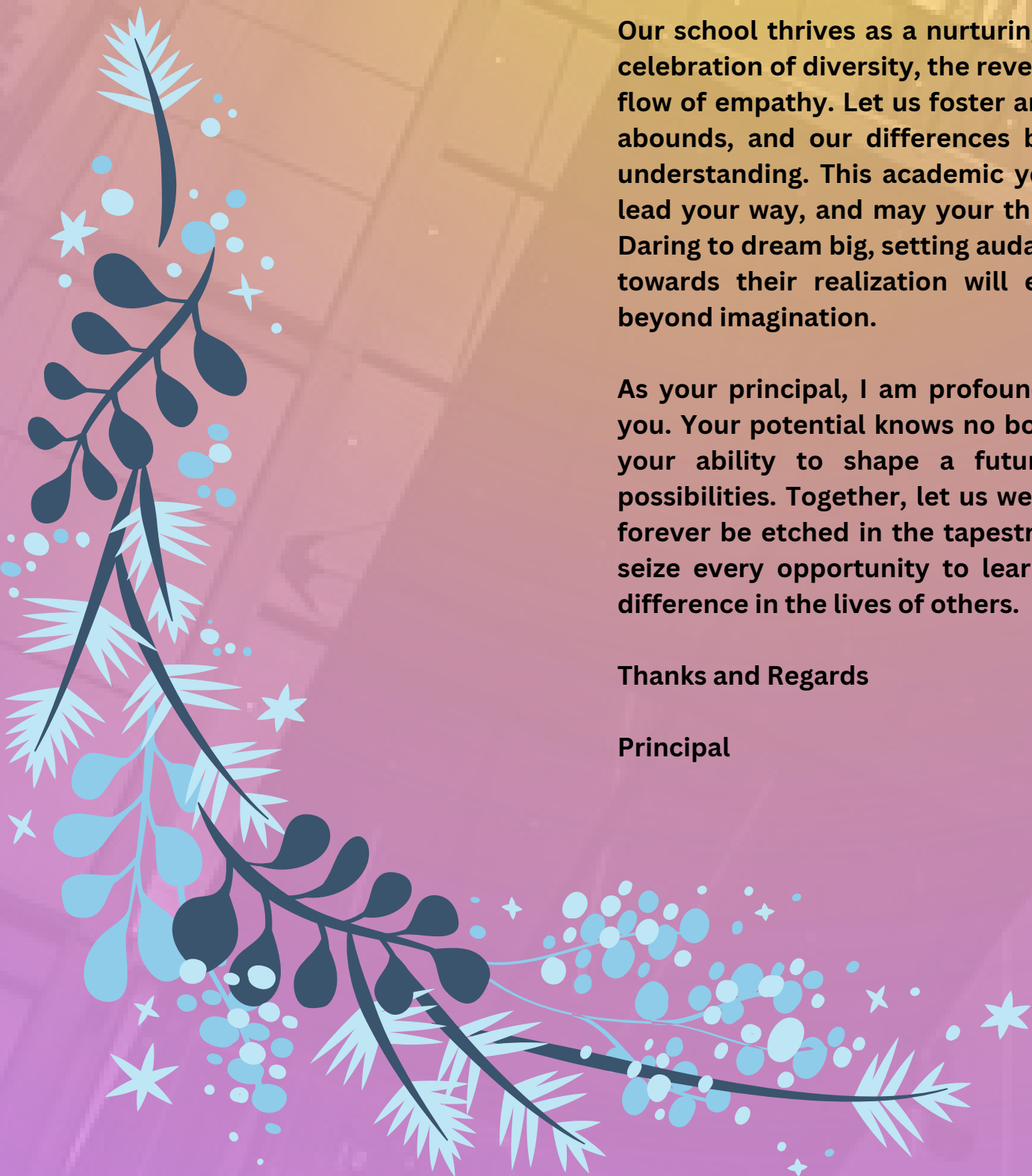

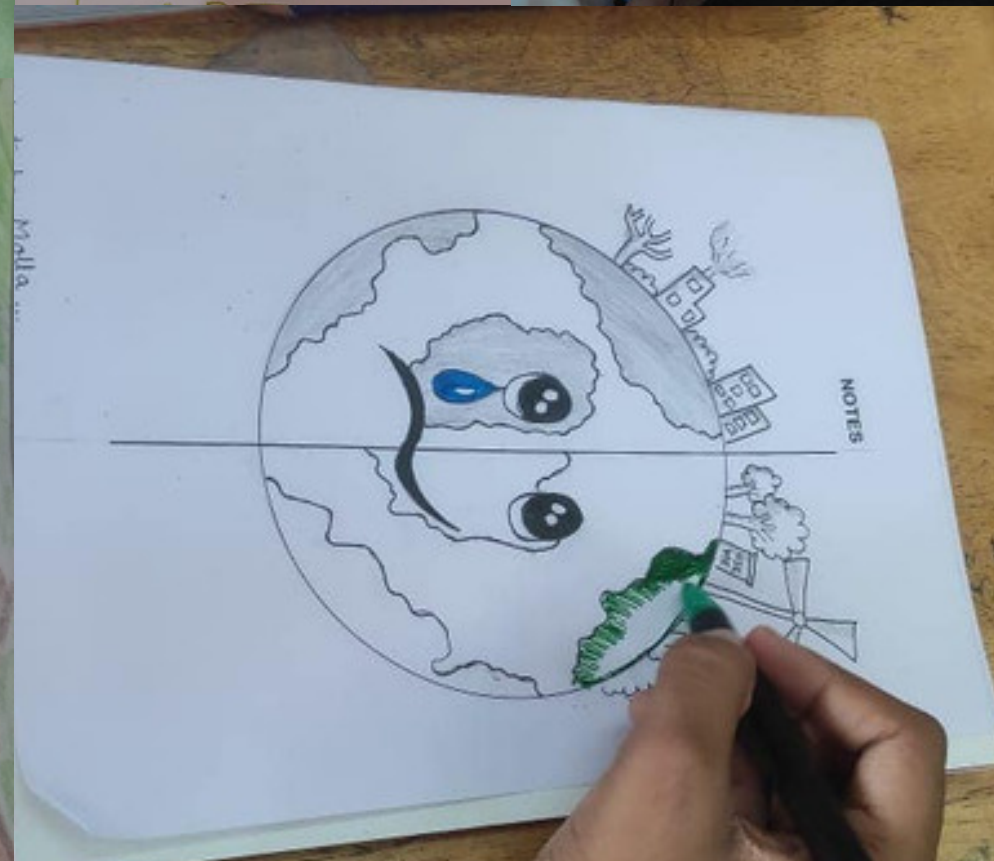

ENGLISH LANGUAGE DAY CELEBRATION

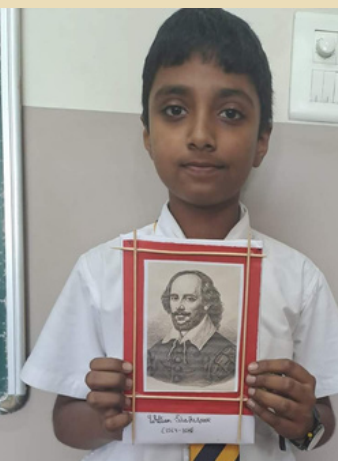
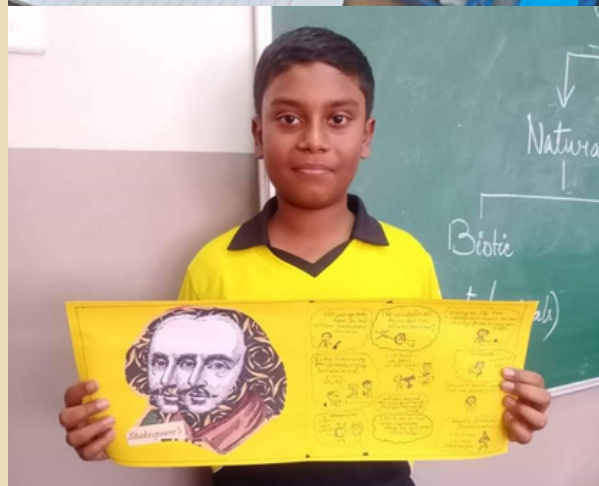
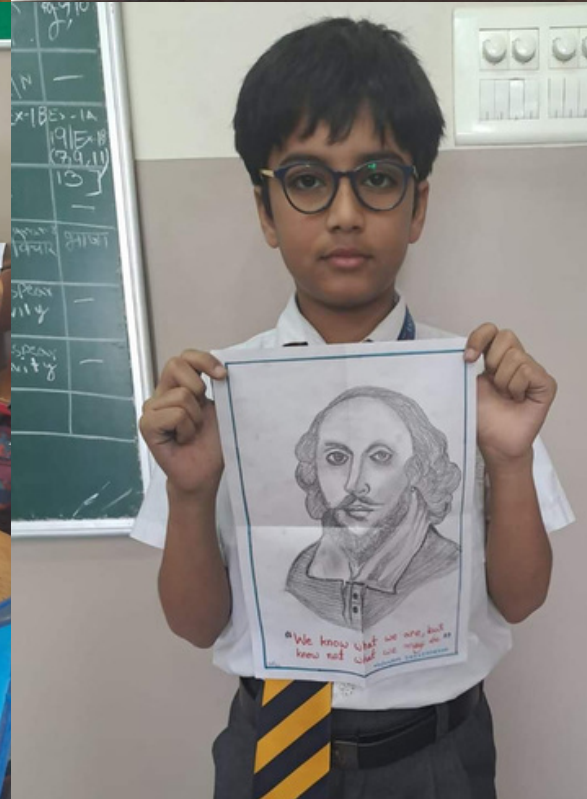
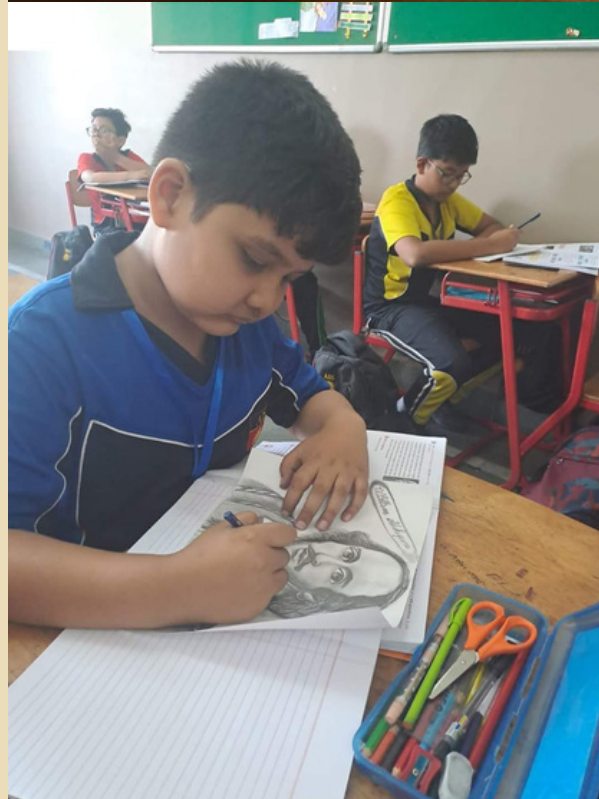
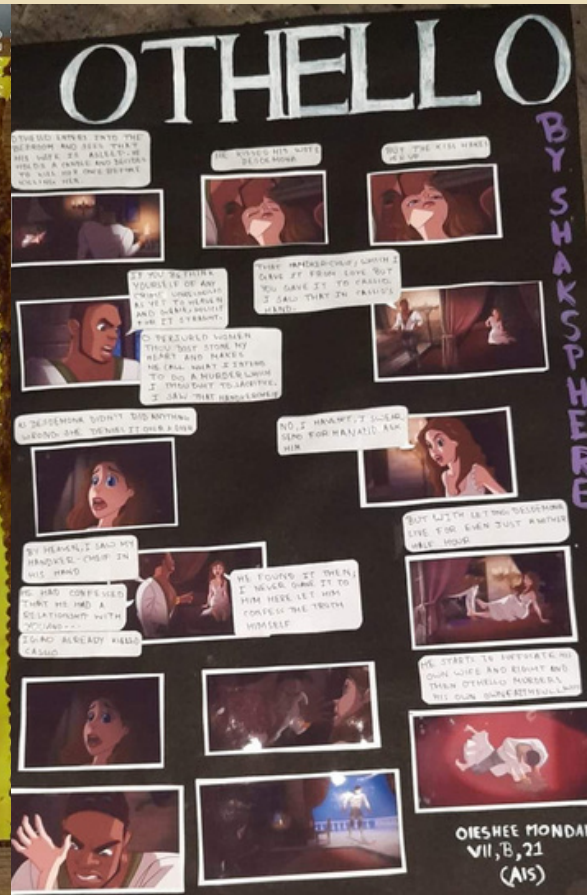
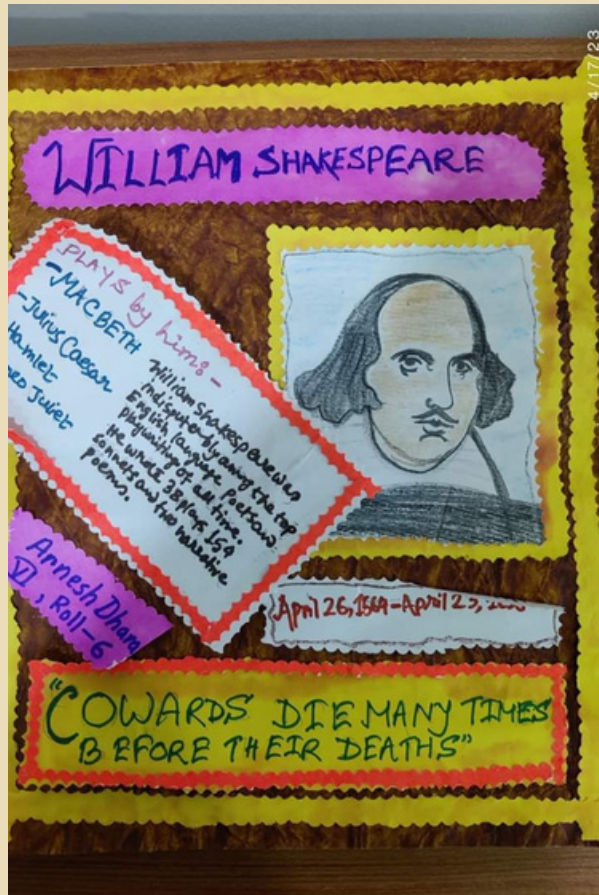

CBSE SCIENCE CHALLENGE

CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM ON HAPPY CLASSROOMS

Education is not just about imparting knowledge and skills; it is also about creating a positive learning environment that fosters student well-being and success. To achieve this, Asian International School recently hosted a Capacity Building Programme on Happy Classrooms organized by the honorable CBSE Centre of Excellence, Bhubneswar, in their school premises for the Pedagogues across Kolkata and Howrah on 21st April, 2023. The workshop focused on equipping teachers with strategies and techniques to create a positive learning environment in their classrooms. The Capacity Building Programme was conducted by Mr. Sankar Prasad Dutta and Mrs. Debi Saha Seal who nurtured the teachers with their exceptional confab on the topic Happy Classrooms. Both the facilitators of the workshop were experts in the field of education and had a wealth of experience in creating happy and positive learning environments. The revered Principal of AIS, Mrs. Vijaylaxmi Kumar, also graced the occasion with her presence. While beginning with the session both the Resource Person stressed on the fact that 'Teachers need to make their happiness a habit and only then a teacher will be able to transform the classroom into a happy place for their children.' The Happy Classrooms workshop began with an engaging ice-breaking session that set a positive tone for the rest of the day. The teachers were asked to introduce themselves and describe one thing that makes them happy. This activity not only helped the teachers to get to know each other but also provided an opportunity for self-introspection. While defining the Johari Window, Mr. Dutta referred to the policy of emotional bank account, where he stressed on the fact that in order to be an effective person one needs to broaden ones open area and curtail the space of unknown area. He further added that the domains of Emotional Intelligence include Self Reflection, Self-Soothing and Empathy. He also mentioned the four core skills of EI which includes Self Awareness, Self-Management, Social Awareness and Relationship Management. This was followed by another activity on self-regulation by Mrs. Seal, where she asked the teachers to think of a situation where they have used the S.T.O.P.P Strategy (STOP, TAKE A BREATH, OBSERVE, PULL BACK, PRACTICE & PROCEED). While, explaining the S.T.O.P.P. Strategy, she mentioned that this strategy can be used during emotional outburst which could help someone behave in a composed manner and overcome emotional imbalance. This was followed by another unique poster making activity where the teachers were asked to list down the challenges faced in the classroom and challenges faced in the staffroom in a chart paper. The enthusiastic teachers came up with distinct list of challenges they face in both the rooms of the same building. Mrs. Saha then decoded the definition of Behavior or Misbehavior. While explicating the reasons for Misbehavior, she mentioned various reasons like trauma, low self-esteem, psychological disorders, poor role models, exposure to violence, ineffective parenting, peer pressure, genetics, development disorder, temperament etc. A video reflecting the skills a teacher in creating empowering spaces was played to highlight the fact that positive intervention brings positive changes in children. Then Mr. Dutta took charge of the session and enlightened the teachers about Happiness Formula which is $H = S + C + V$. With the help of an activity, he explained the point that we can use Story telling approach to enhance the learning environment. On the other hand, he also inspired the schools to focus on Total Physical Response which includes activities like Group Singing, Simon Says with a Twist, Role play, Pantomime Actions etc. After an impactful delivery on Mood Meter, the session paved way for a short assessment session, branching across twenty-five inquisitive questions, which was served with utmost and varied illustrations by the teachers. This was followed by the felicitation of both the honorable personalities by the esteemed Principal. The session was really encouraging and provided the team of teachers' valuable insights and strategies for creating a positive learning environment and promoting student well-being. The workshop emphasized the importance of building positive relationships, engaging students in their learning, effective communication, and creating a safe and inclusive classroom culture. The workshop has motivated the teachers to implement these strategies and techniques they learned in their classrooms, and to create happy and positive learning environments for their students.

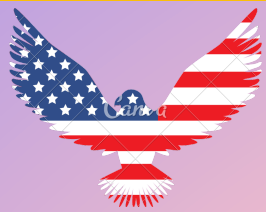


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INTERCONNECTED - INTERSCHOOL VENTURES OF AIS

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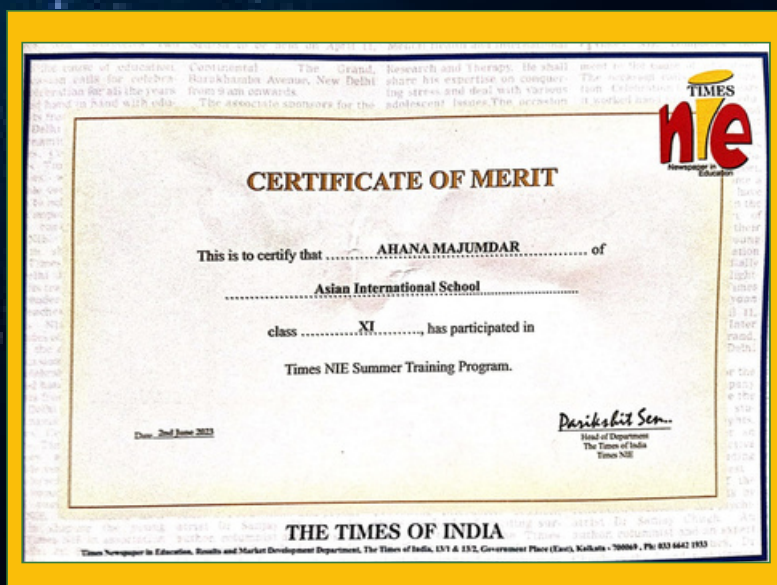

Kolkata: The national eligibility cum entrance test, 2023 (NEET-UG) was held from 2pm to 5.20pm on Sunday and the test was conducted peacefully across Bengal.

A candidate from Birbhum arrived at Asian International School, Howrah, around 1.25pm on Sunday to take the test. After document verifications, it was learnt that his correct centre was elsewhere.
