























TECHIE'S HUB

MODEL MAKING COMPETITION - ISRO









INTER CLASS VERNACULAR RECITATION COMPETITION





























INDEPENDENCE DAY AND INVESTITURE CEREMONY









NOBLE WOMEN - BENGALI DEPT




SLOGAN WRITING COMPETITION




Erudit' 20 - LITERARY FEST - ALLEN HOUSE PUBLIC SCHOOL

CBSE CLASS X RESULTS

ne toppers from Asian International School for Class X CBSE examinations are Shounak Ghosh with 97.2%, Lakshya Jain with 96.8%, Aritri Samanta with 96.6%. Among those appeared eight students got above 95% and 22 of them above 90%. The class average is 79.85%.

The toppers from Adamas World School for Class X CBSE are Ankana Dey with 96.4%, Titirsha Chakravarty with 96.2%, Saptarshi Roy with 96%, Suhani Sarkar with 95.4%, Samadrita Sarkar and Siddhartho Oraw, both with 95.2%. The average percentage of the school is 85%. Altogether 43 students appeared for the examination out of which all 43 passed. Twenty-one students scored 90% and above, 13 scored between 80% to 89%, 4 scored between 70% to 79%, 4 scored between 60% to 69% and only one scored between 50% to 59%.

The toppers from DPS Howrah Class X CBSE examinations are Adiptya Ghosh with 97.8%, Akansha Kedia with 97.4% and Khushi Mehta with Mishra topped in IT with 99%.

The toppers in English are Akansha Kedia and Khushi Mehta with 98%. Abir Banerjee, Jayanta and above. Saha, Akansha Kedia and Sourodeep Dey scored 98% in Mathematics. Adiptya Ghosh scored 99% in Science. He also scored 99% in Social Science.
