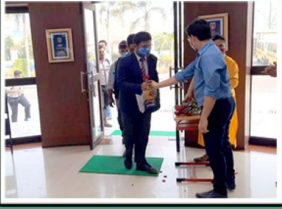
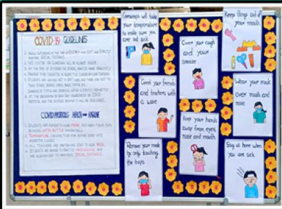




AIS OPENS THE GATE FOR THE EDUCATES

FUN AND FROLIC ACTIVITY



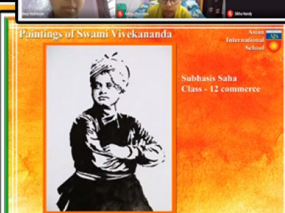
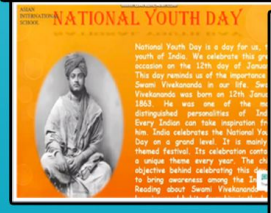
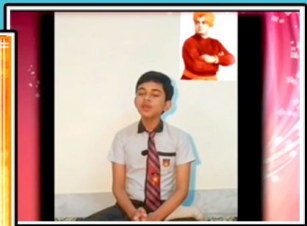
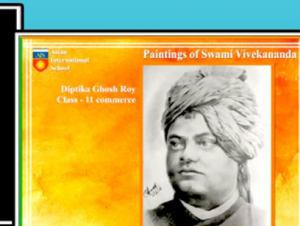
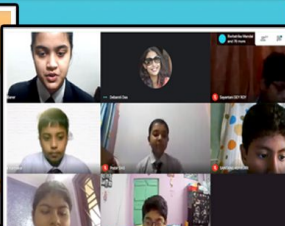
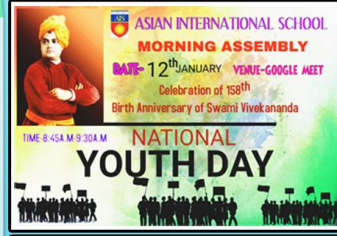

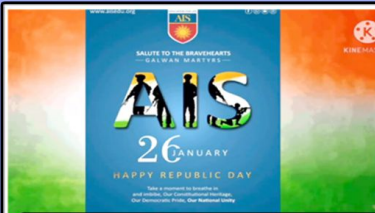
NATIONAL YOUTH DAY

"We are what our thoughts have made us; so take care about what you think. Words are secondary. Thoughts live; they travel far." - Swami Vivekananda.

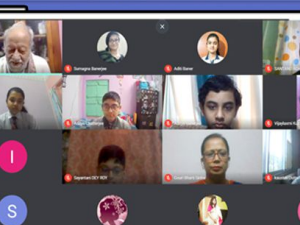
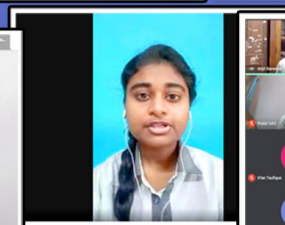

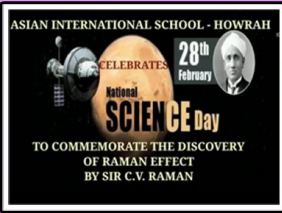

SARASWATI PUJA

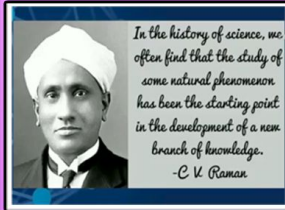

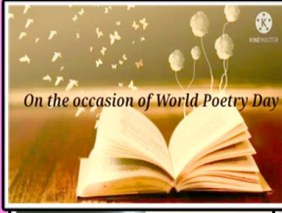
Objectives of National Science Day :
The basic purpose of this day is to inspire students to new experiments, attract them to Science and make them aware of Science and Scientific achievements.



Raman Effect :
While sailing across the Mediterranean in 1911 to Europe as a delegate to Oxford University, the deep blue ocean that caught his attention made Raman suspect the validity of Lord Rayleigh's theory that blue colour of the sea is merely a reflection of the sky.
He initiated an experiment on the scattering of light by molecules of liquid. Eventually this led to the discovery of 'Raman Effect' that won him a Nobel prize in physics in 1930 making India the first Asian country to win the honour of such a distinction.



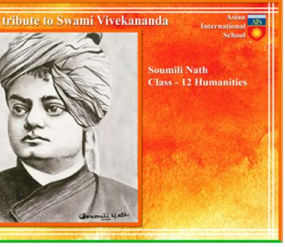
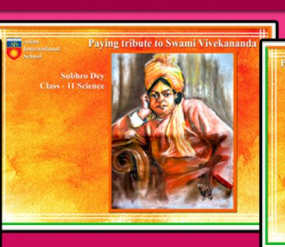
WORLD POETRY DAY CELEBRATION
